
MAJOR PARTITION

CREATION OF PRIVATE ROAD

LOCATED IN THE SE 1/4 SEC. 32, T. 34S., R.IE., W. M.



SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PRARGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Gregg Adams 2120 Oakwood Dr. Medford, Oregon

LOCATION:

SE 1/4 Sec. 32, T.34S., R.1E., W.M., Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

Major Land Partition. Creation of Private Road. To locate. monument, map and provide legal descriptions for the private road and parcels 1, 2, and 3 as shown on the accompanying map.

PROCEDURE:

I found the monuments as shown. The center of the section and C-E 1/16 monuments described in RS 6229 and the SE section corner were missing. Thus I traversed to the North and West 1/4 corners of Sec. 32 which I found intact and the South 1/4 corner of Sec. 33 which was not found. However, the pile of rocks and bearing trees described in the county re-establishment notes were found and the corner was used to re-establish the SE section corner of Sec. 32. I set a 5/8"x30" steel pin from which:

A 6" W. Oak bears N.85°W, 29.4 feet mkd. w/ blaze, scribed S. 32. A 5" Oak bears S.68° 30'W, 50.6 feet mkd w/ blaze, scribed S. 5. A 12" Pine bears S.56°E, 113.7 feet mkd w/ blaze, scribed S.4.

A 12th Pine bears N.630E, 125.3 feet mkd w/ blaze, scribed S. 33.

I also set a 5/8"x30" steel pin at the Center of Section 32 from which:

A 12" D. Fir bears N.66°E, 21.7 feet mkd w/ 2 blazes. A 18" Pine bears N.32° 30'W, 38.1 feet mkd w/ 2 blazes.

Using the above monuments and the requirements of the Jackson County Planning Department I set 5/8" steel pins as shown on the accompanying map.
