LOCATION: Situated in the Northwest quarter of Section 14, Township 39
South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and Meridian,
Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To survey and monument those parcels of land as shown hereon
per clients request.

PROCEDURE: A search was made for previously established survey monuments.
Most were found with some being found disturbed and one corner
missing entirely. Due to the vast amount of construction
activity that has been and is underway, it was felt that to
insure the correct location of said pins that a measurement
check of those pins found should be made. The results are
as shown on the accompanying map.

Basis of Bearing was derived from the National Oceanic and
Atmospheric Administration (formerly Coast & Geodetic Survey)
survey net, as established in 1968 and on file in the office
of the Jackson County Surveyor.
