The East boundary of the tract described in Inst. No. 76-22853 O.R. was created by the conveyance of the tract described in Volume 284 Deeds, Page 487. This boundary was established at record distance (198.00 feet) West of the NE corner of the West-half of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 32 and at record bearing (due South) to agree with the original conveyance.

The East boundary of the tract described in Volume 469 Deeds, Page 244 was established at record distance (1093.47 feet) West of the North Quarter corner of Section 32 and the West boundary was established along the East boundary of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 32.

The tract described in Inst. No. 79-00801 O.R., being the Junior tract, was located between the East boundary of the tract described in Volume 469 Deeds, Page 244 and the West boundary of the tract described in Volume 284 Deeds, Page 487.

The physical location of the tract described in Volume 344

Deeds, Page 146 was determined from found monuments and fence lines which have denoted the tract boundaries for many years.

The location of the tract described in Inst. No. 76-13477 O.R. is dependent on the location of the tract described in Volume 344 Deeds, Page 146 and was monumented accordingly.

## PURPOSE:

1. To utilize existing monuments and occupation lines indicating the physical location of the tract described in Volume 344 Deeds, Page 146 for boundary line agreement purposes.

Also to monument the tract described in Inst. No. 76-13477 O.R., positioning same per record distances relative to the occupation lines of the tract described in Volume 344 Deeds, Page 146. The physical location on the ground of these two tracts does not substantially change.

- 2. To monument and re-describe the tract described in Inst. No. 79-00801 O.R.
- 3. To monument the Northwest corner and set witness corners for the East boundary of the tract described in Inst. No. 76-22853 O.R.
- 4. To monument the tract described in Volume 469 Deeds, Page 244. A witness corner was set near the Southwest corner of this tract since the bearing of the East boundary of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 32 was not determined on this survey.
- 5. To prepare a revised description of the tract described in Inst. No. 76-13477 O.R.

All of the subject tracts are located in the NW 1/4 of Section 32, T32SR3E, W.M.

PROCEDURE: The North Quarter corner (see Filed Survey No. 7306) and the Northwest corner of Section 32 (C.S.) were tied via a random traverse utilizing a one-second theodolite, EDM equipment and chain.
