## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Howard G. Jacobson 4190 Charlotte Lane Phoenix, Oregon 97535

LOCATION:

Southwest one-quarter (1/4) of Section 16, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

To monument a point where the north line of our client's property, when extended west, intersects with the west line of Section 16. This point is understood not to be a property corner

PROCEDURE: Utilizing control established by this office for Survey No. 5235 and 5560, set the control point as shown on the attached map. The two monuments found on the South line of the subject tract were found to be in error. A review of the legal descriptions of the subject tract and the tract to the South finds both referring to 5/8 inch iron pins at the corner points which, in this case, would take precedence over the distance calls in these descriptions. Our client was informed of the problem.
