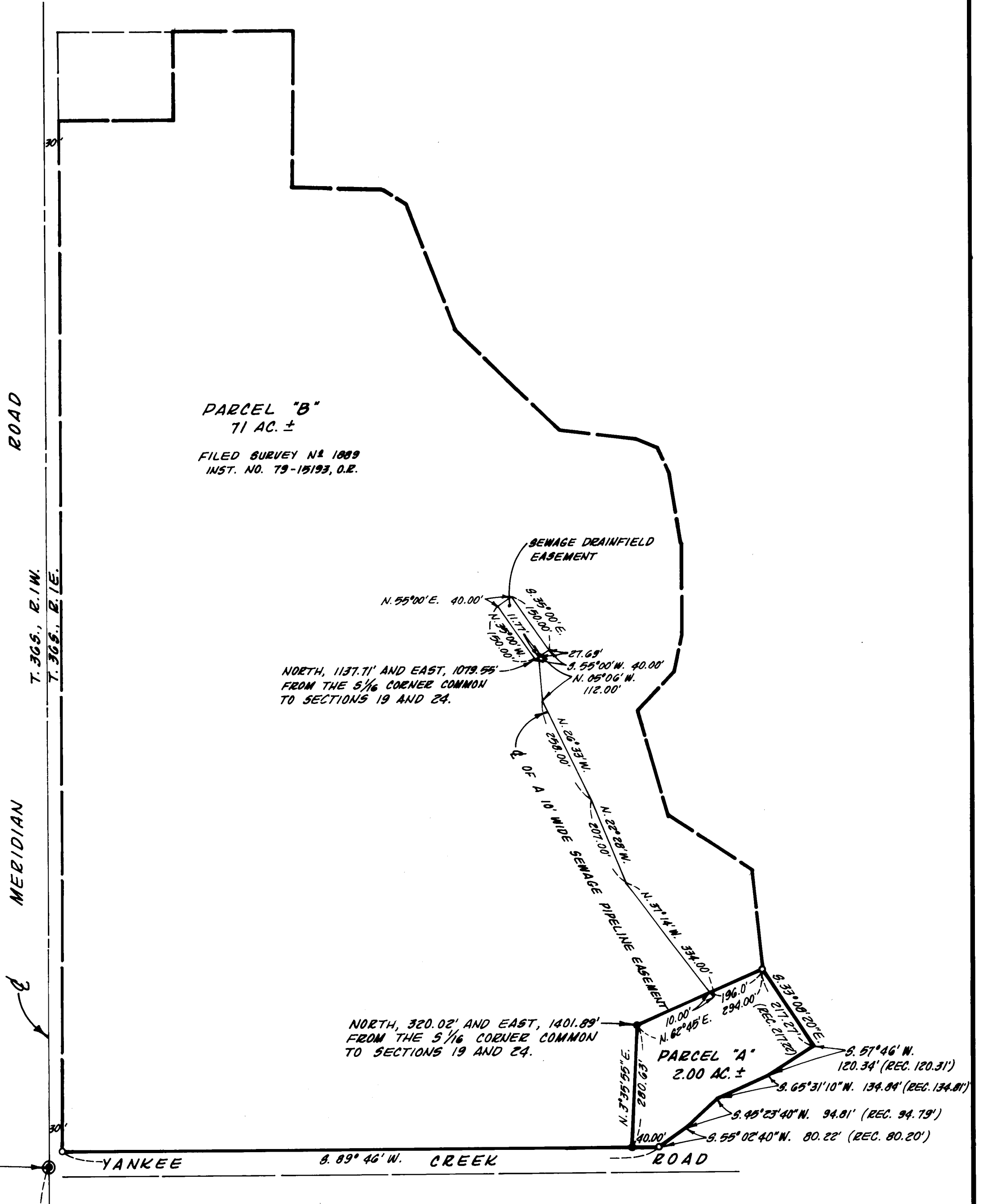

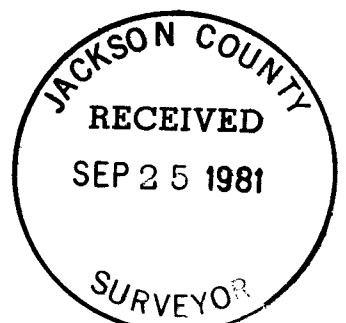

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PURPOSE: To monument an approved "Minor Land Partition" located in Section 19, T36SR1E, W.M. This partition was approved by the Jackson County Department of Planning and Development under the "non-farm dwelling" ordinance (see File No. 81-2-NF).

Also to describe the non-farm dwelling parcel and sewage pipeline and drainfield easements.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing monuments set on Filed Survey No. 1889 for control, the desired non-farm dwelling parcel was monumented as shown on the annexed map.

The South boundary of Survey No. 1889 appears to be monumented along the fence as it existed then which may or may not be the right-of-way of Yankee Creek Road.
