SURVEY FOR:

Mr. David Harrington 7500 Dead Indian Road Ashland, Oregon 97520

LOCATION:

Situated in the Southwest quarter of Section 23, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey the boundaries of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter and a small portion of the East and West boundaries of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 23 and to survey the existing location of Tolman Creek Road in the vicinity of said boundary lines.

PROCEDURE:

From control previously established in the course of Recorded Surveys No. 5668 and 6081 proceeded to expand said control into the area of this survey and monument the corners as shown on the accompanying map.

Basis of Bearing was derived from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (formerly Coast & Geodetic Survey) survey net, as established in 1968 and on file in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.
