

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

LOCATION:

Situated in a portion of Lot 3 of Block 26 in the City of Ashland per the 1883 map thereof and a portion of the vacated alley as set forth in Ordinance No. 202 in said city.

**PURPOSE:** 

To survey and monument the outer boundary of the clients ownership and set line stakes on the Northwesterly and Southeasterly boundary lines.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing control and monumentation found or set in the execution of Recorded Surveys No. 4702, 4807, 4897 and 5050 proceeded to establish the outer boundary lines of Volume 186, page 259 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon. The vacated portion of an alley was established as shown on the accompanying map. Along the Southeasterly boundary line there is some utilization of the clients ownership by the neighbor to the East. They were both present when the boundary stakes were set and indicated that no problem was created in terms of the boundary line as surveyed and occupational objects that now exist. The reminder of the survey is as shown on the accompanying map.
