Swain, duly Registered Surveyor of the State of Oregon, being duly sworn, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with the proper monuments as provided by law the tract of land hereon shown and the plat is a correct representation of the same, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines:
