## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Pacific Power & Light Co. 920 S.W. Sixth Avenue Portland, Oregon 97204

LOCATION:

Donation Land Claim No. 67 and Northeast onequarter (1/4) of Section 28, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson

County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

To survey, monument, and redescribe the tract of land originally described in Document No. 81-10551 of the Jackson County Official Records and now shows as Parcel No. 1 on the attached map. This is a Minor Land Partition to comply with the conditions set forth in Jackson County file #81-25-MP.

**EQUIPMENT:** 

Wild Tl-A and Lietz Red-1

PROCEDURE: Using control established by this office for Survey No. 6766, continued traverse to South and tied in the Southwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 67. This verified the position of the witness monument set 87.02 feet South of the centerline of Hanley Road per Survey No. 1749 as being on the Donation Land Claim line.


The right of way line for Hanley Road was determined from control set for Survey No. 1749. A review of the narrative found that local surveyor Mark E. Boyden had used existing fence lines in this area to determine its right of way. Review of 1963 field notes by the county road department found original spikes set for a P-line survey at Stations 0+00, 18+10.72, 29+32.97, and 31+69.55. These spikes were located and tied in and compared quite closely with the field date recorded in the 1963 field notes and also shown on County Map F-3-3. Consultation with Dale Petrasek, County Road Department, also confirmed that the 1963 survey was only a P-line survey in nature and did not represent the legal centerline of Hanley Road. With this, it was decided to be consistent with the right of way line established per Survey No. 1749.

With the Southeasterly right of way line of Hanley Road now located, the control established per Survey No. 7353 was reviewed, oriented to this survey and coordinated. With this control, the Northwesterly boundary of the tract described in Volume 364, page 193, of the Jackson County Deed Records was determined which left a considerable gap between the deed line and the right of way line.

After Pacific Power & Light Co. was informed of the problem, we were instructed to monument the boundaries of the Parcel No. 1 as originally instructed, to prepare a description for the area in question, and to redescribe Parcel No. 1 to be consistent with this survey. At the time of the writing of this narrative, action is being taken to resolve the title problem of the area in question.
