PURPOSE: To partition the tract described in Inst. No. 80-01207 O.R. being located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 36, T36SR2W, W.M. as approved for Minor Land Partition by the Jackson County Department of Planning and Development staff on September 29, 1981 (see Planning File 81-92-MP).

PROCEDURE: From controls set or utilized on Filed Surveys 1382 and 2791, the desired parcels were monumented as shown on the annexed map. The North-South boundaries of the subject tracts were monumented at right angles to the East-West center line of Section 36 because this agrees favorably with the fence improvements and is also in accordance with previous surveys (see Filed Survey Nos. 256 and 8908). The North boundary of the subject tract was located 424.22 feet from the East-West center line to agree with the original partitioners North boundary (see tract described in Vol. 216, Page 197 D.R.).
