



SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PURPOSE: To complete the Minor Land Partition surveys as approved by the Jackson County Department of Planning and Development (81-118-MP) on December 16, 1981.

PROCEDURE: The exterior boundaries of the overall tract were not required to be accurately positioned and were not established on this survey. Ties were made to monuments found as shown on the annexed plat. The newly created boundaries between Parcels 1 & 2 were monumented as shown, tying same to the Southeast corner of Section 30, as monumented by a concrete monument with bronze disk in a monument case by the County Surveyor's Department in 1979.

The field work was accomplished with E.D.M. equipment. Meridian was established by a mean of six solar observations taken at the Southeast corner of said Section 30.
