BASIS OF BEARING:

Survey No. 6676 by Thomas as shown, S0°19'02"W.

SURVEY LOCATION:

Located in the NW. 1/4 of Sec. 4, T39S, R1E, WM. (reference monument is in the SW 1/4 of

Sec. 33, T38S, R1E, WM.).

PURPOSE OF SURVEY:

To establish new property lines between the City of Ashland, Harold Hardesty and George Helfrich for the purpose of preparing property and easement descriptions for conveyance of a deeded roadway and utility right-of-way from Oak Street to city owned properties and sewage treatment plant; for additional lands owned by Harold Hardesty to be deeded to the City of Ashland.

The above is as directed by that certain Jackson County Circuit Court case No. 79-2929-E-1. Final Decree and a side letter "Memorandum of Understanding".

PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

A closed traverse was ran from the NW. corner of D.L.C. No. 53, T38S, R1E, WM. down Oak St. along the existing sewer manhole covers (in place as they exist at this time), as shown on the map, along an existing fence line bordering Ashland Creek and back to said DLC corner. Prior survey data utilized for bearing control and / or property line locations were:

Recorded Survey No. 6676; 5576; 5597 and 6119.

Following computations, appropriate deed, final decree and recorded survey information, I staked the line as shown on the map. Property lines not surveyed are either shown as dashes or dotted lines and are based upon a combination of record deed information and/or recorded surveys data.

Equipment: A Kern DKM2 and a Beetle 2000S, Electronic Meter.
