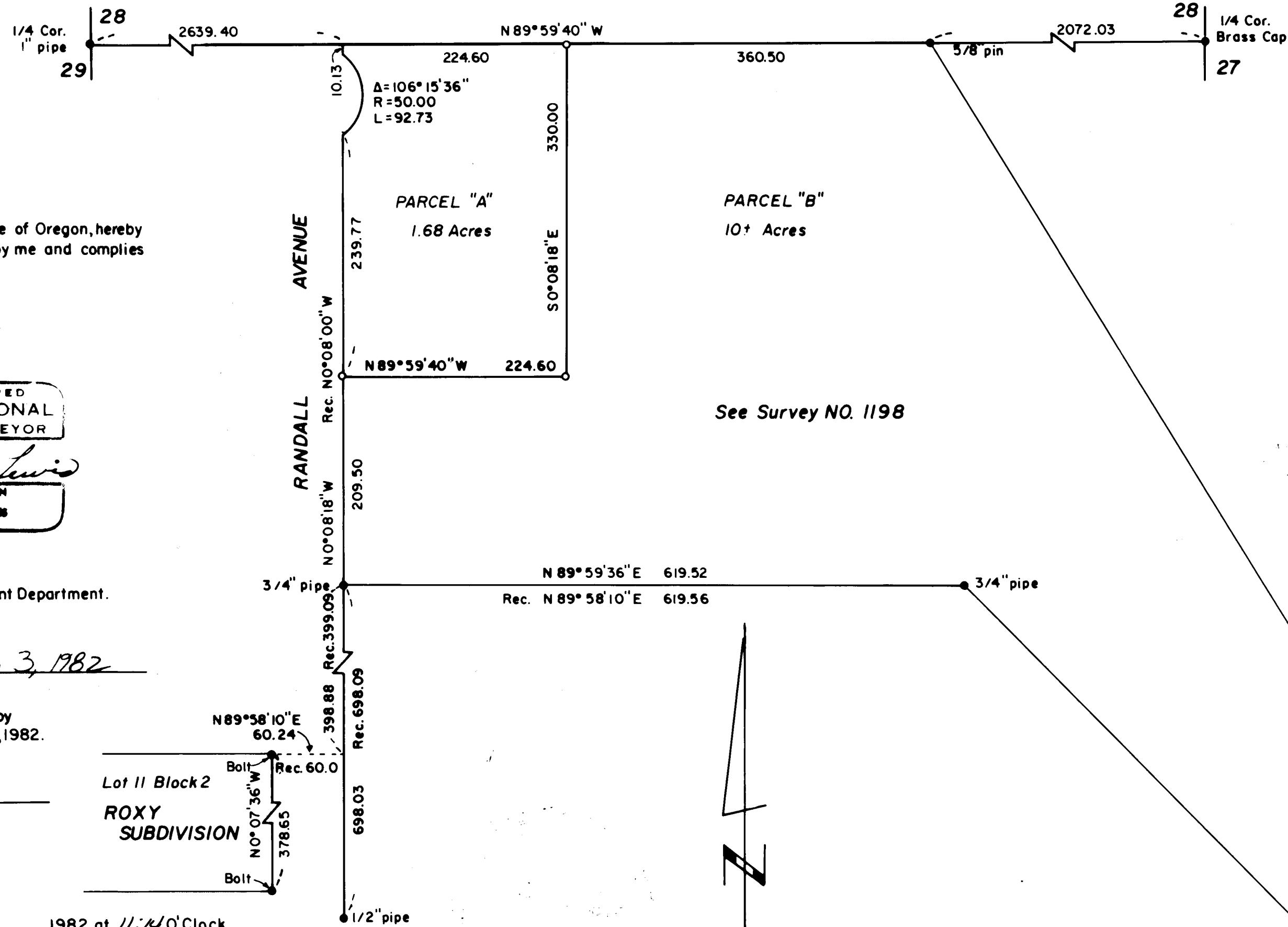

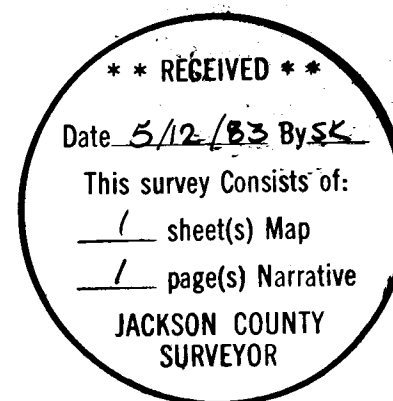

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

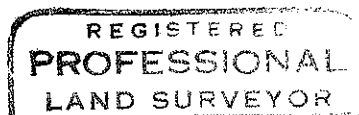
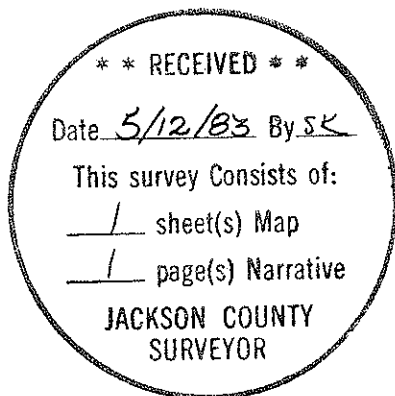

Purpose: To survey and monument a Minor Land Partition according to preliminary plat approval granted by the Jackson County Planning Department File No. 82-11 M.P.

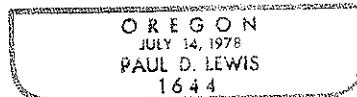
