At the East One-Sixteenth corner common to Sections 11 and 14, set a 3/4" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 33" in the ground with a 2" bronze cap marked:

RLS 803 E 1/16 S11 S14 1982

from which:

A 6" Yellow Pine scribed "E 1/16 S11 BT" bears N 34 $3/4^{\circ}$ W, 38.6 feet to the center at the lower blaze.

A 26" Red Fir scribed "E 1/16 S14 BT" bears S 41° W, 35.5 feet to the center at the lower blaze.

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PURPOSE: To monument the Quarter corner and the East One-Sixteenth

corner between Sections 14 and 23 and to monument the East One-Sixteenth corner between Sections 11 and 14,

all in T34SRlW, W.M.

PROCEDURE: A one-second theodolite and EDM equipment was utilized to run a traverse between the Southwest and Southeast corners of Section 14 and between the Northeast corner and North Quarter corner of Section 14 with a meridian tie between the two traverses.

After a search for the South Quarter corner with no definite original evidence being found, the desired corners were set at proportionate positions.

Basis of Bearings is Filed Survey No. 8172.

At the Quarter corner common to Sections 14 and 23, set a 3/4" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 33" in the ground with a 2" bronze cap marked:

T34SR1W S14 1/4 S23 RPLS 803 1981

from which:

An 11" White Oak scribed "1/4 S23 BT" bears S 62 1/2° W, 30.2 feet to the center at the lower blaze.

A 5" White Oak scribed "1/4 S14 BT" bears N 58 1/4° W, 19.1 feet to the center at the lower blaze.

At the East One-Sixteenth corner common to Sections 14 and 23, set a 3/4" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 33" in the ground with a
