

MINOR LAND PARTITION

Refer to Parcels No. 2 and 3 on map filed for record the 28th day of May, 1982, at 2:38 PM in Vol. 5 Pg. 40 of the "Minor Land Partitions" in Jackson County, Oregon

PARCEL NO. 2

COMMENCING at a brass cap monumenting the Northwest corner of Section 18, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon; thence South along the West line of said Section 18, a distance of 1304.01 feet to a point that bears West from a 5/8 inch iron pin; thence leaving said West section line East 738.22 feet, more or less, to said 5/8 inch iron pin for the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence North 1217.08 feet to a 5/8 inch iron pin witness monument; thence continue North 36 feet, more or less, to intersect the average traveled centerline of Long Branch Road (County Road); thence in a Southeasterly direction along said centerline to a point that bears East of the point of beginning; thence leaving said centerline West 53 feet, more or less, to a 5/8 inch iron pin witness monument; thence continue West 2052.85 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 46 gross acres, more or less.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion of the above described parcel lying within the boundaries of the tract described in Volume 187, page 145 of the Deed Records in Jackson County, Oregon.

PARCEL NO. 3

COMMENCING at a brass cap monumenting the Northwest corner of Section 18, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon; thence South along the West line of said Section 18, a distance of 1304.01 feet to a point that bears West from a 5/8 inch iron pin, said point being the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence leaving said West section line East 738.22 feet, more or less, to said 5/8 inch iron pin; thence continue East 2052.85 feet to a 5/8 inch iron pin witness monument; thence continue East 53 feet, more or less, to intersect the average traveled centerline of Long Branch Road (County Road); thence in a Southeasterly direction along said centerline to intersect the East-West centerline of said Section 18; thence leaving said road centerline, West along said East-West centerline of Section 18, to the West one-quarter (1/4) corner of said Section 18; thence North along the West line of said Section 18 to the point of beginning. Containing 98 gross acres, more or less.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion of the above described parcel lying within the boundaries of the tract described in Volume 187, page 145 of the Deed Records in Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey, monument, and describe the parcels and comply with the conditions as set forth in Jackson County File 82-9-MP as shown on accompanying map

PROCEDURE: Using control established in Survey No. 9082 by this office continued traversing Southeasterly along the approximate centerline of Long Branch Road and tied into the East one-quarter (1/4) corner of Section 18. It is the intent of this partitioning that the appropriate lines of Parcels No. 1, 2, and 3 be coincident with the centerline of Long Branch Road and they are described accordingly. The interior lines were monumented in the field per clients' request and the exterior lines are the West line of Section 7, the West line of Section 18, the East-West centerline of Section 18, and the centerline of Long Branch Road.
