SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

LOCATION:

Situated in Donation Land Claim No. 45 in the Northwest quarter and the Northeast quarter of Section 15, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and partition that tract of land as set forth in Volume 429, page 271 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon per $\,$ client's request and approval by the City of Ashland Planning Department.

PROCEDURE:

In retracing this description, as set forth in Volume 429, page 271 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon, it was found that the course along Siskiyou Boulevard to the point of beginning was not compatable with any other documents or the call for the North-easterly corner of said tract to be 306 feet Northwesterly of the right of way intersection of Siskiyou Boulevard and Walker Avenue. After a thorough anallsis of adjoiner deeds, improvements on the ground, etc, it was decided to hold the deed distance of 306 feet Northwesterly along Siskiyou Boulevard to fix the Northeast corner Thence holding deed record angle from the right of way of Siskiyou Boulevard, continued in a clockwise direction around said parcel and computed the closure of the last course of said deed into the Southwesterly right of way of Siskiyou Boulevard; this checks the deed record distance within 0.135 foot which is very good. Also, the beginning course was calculated back to the Northeast corner of said parcel as referred to hereinabove. This distance checks record within 0.10 foot.

Frances Lane was reviewed and found to be a junior deed to the parcel being surveyed; However, in retracing the deed record of said right of way, using my anallsis of the retracement of the clients parcel of land as hereinabove referred to, Frances Lane is 44.92 feet in width (deed record 45 feet) instead of the possibility of having some 6 foot, more or less, discrepancy exist between the two (2) described tracts of land.

It should be noted that Frances Lane as monumented Southerly of this survey is not compatable with its deed record location. Therefore, caution is urged when dealing with land lines in relation to the right of way of Frances Lane both Northerly and Southerly of Oregon Street.

The remainder of the survey and data has been shown on the accompanying maps. I believe with deligent review by the viewer of said maps, enough information is available to see what course, and the extent thereof, was taken and utilized by this surveyor.
