SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES.

SURVEY FOR: Rolen Rosecrans & Ron Wells

925 Galls Creek Road Gold Hill, Oregon

PURPOSE: Minar Land Partition to survey, monument and describe 1.74

acre tract of land.

LOCATION: Southwest quarter of Section 21, Township 36 South, Range 3

West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE:

Found Jackson County Surveyor's Brass Cap Monuments at West 1/4 corner and Northwest corner of Section 21. Found 5/8 inch steel pins at or near South 1/4 corner and Southwest corner of Section 21. No record of the origin of the 5/8 inch steel pins. Jackson County Survey crew visited these corner positions but could not find enough evidence to monument. However, the South line of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 has apparently been fenced using the above mentioned 5/8 inch steel pins for line. Client agreed that a boundary line agreement would be in order between Tax Lot 1601 and Parcel No. 1 as monumented in this survey. Tied all found points together and set 5/8 inch by 30 inch steel pins as shown on the accompanying plat. Attached yellow plastic cap stamped "DW Edwards-LS 741" to all steel pins set.
