At the center South one-sixteenth (1/16) corner of Section 30, I set a  $5/8" \times 30"$  iron pin from which;

A 16" Madrone bears N 20° E 27.1 feet, scribed CS 1/16, BT.

A 14" Madrone bears N 74° W 8.3 feet, scribed CS 1/16, BT.

At the Southeast one-sixteenth (1/16) corner of Section 30, I set a  $5/8" \times 30"$  iron pin from which;

A 14" Pine bears N 18° E 15.2 feet, scribed SE 1/16, BT.

A 4" Fir bears N 89° W 30.2 feet, scribed SE 1/16, BT.

This Survey is being refiled to show who established the monuments at the Southwest corner, the Northwest corner and the Northeast corner of Section 30.

A portion of Section 30, Township 37 South, Range 3, West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey, establish and mark the Boise Cascade Corporation's property lines as shown on the attached map.

PROCEDURE:

A traverse was run around the exterior boundary of said Section 30 using a 10 second theodolite and E.D.M. equipment. The North and West one-quarter (1/4) corners could not be found after a diligent search was made. Therefore, prorated distances were used to set said corners. Boise Cascade Corporation's property lines were marked with a combination of blazed and painted trees, and tags stamped BCCPL.

After finding the corners as shown on the attached map and fractionizing said Section 30, I set the following corners and scribed trees as follows:

At the North one-quarter (1/4) corner of Section 30 I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin from which:

A 17" Madrone bears N 60° E 24.3 feet, scribed S 1/4 Sec 19, BT.

A 16" Madrone bears S 10° E 26.1 feet, scribed N 1/4 Sec 30, BT.

At the West one-quarter (1/4) corner of Section 30 I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin from which;

An 8" Madrone bears N 89° E 36.5 feet, scribed W 1/4 S 30, BT.

A 22" Fir bears S 62° W 17.0 feet, scribed E 1/4 S 25, BT.

At the center West one-sixteenth (1/16) corner of Section 30, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin from which;


A 10" Fir bears N 87° E 27.0 feet, scribed CW 1/16, BT.

A 10" Madrone bears S 26° E 38.6 feet, scribed CW 1/16, BT.

A 6" Madrone bears N  $65^{\circ}$  E 11.9 feet, scribed SW 1/16, BT.

A 4" Pine bears N  $50^{\circ}$  W 10.6 feet, scribed SW 1/16, BT.
