

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED SATUTES

LOCATION:

Situated in the Southwest quarter of Section 9, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and Meridian, Jackson County,

Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument that tract or parcel of land as set forth in Document No. 78-19774 of the Official Records of Jackson County,

Oregon per clients request.

PROCEDURE:

A copy of Recorded Survey No. 4103 and a copy of the Coeur D'Alene Subdivision, as now recorded, was secured. After acquiring copies of deeds for adjoiner properties, as called for in the client's deed, an analyzation was made of the relationship of the various deed record boundaries to see if compatibility existed between said boundary lines. It became apparent that discrepanies existed in many cases. Recorded Survey No. 4103 indicates that the monumentation found for Coeur D'Alene Subdivision was not compatible with plat record. Therefore, it was deemed necessary to recover the monumentation of said Coeur D'Alene Subdivision, as well as those monuments as set in the course of Recorded Survey No. 4103. This gathered data was combined with information previously established by this office and then analyzation of the deeds of record with the found monuments or purported monuments was undertaken. It became apparent that overlaps, gaps, overplatted subdivision boundaries and the lack of dedicated or conveyed street rights of way existed. The latitude position of the client's property was determined; however, it became apparent that witness corners along the Easterly and Westerly boundary lines were warranted. The witness corners along the Westerly boundary line, were set where the possible Easterly right of way of Terrace Street might someday be conveyed to the City of Ashland. The witness corners along the Easterly boundary line were set at the location of the Westerly boundary line of Coeur D'Alene Subdivision, as found monumented. This Westerly boundary as found, overplats its official record location by a considerable amount. This condition was not resolved. There may be conditions existing for the claim of adverse possession, but this condition would need to be reviewed with an attorney. Anyway, the parcel of land was monumented, as shown on the accompanying map, and conditions shown thereon in relation to the various deed record boundaries and found monuments.

BASIS OF BEARING:

True Meridian at the N-S centerline of Section 9 as derived from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (formerly Coast and Geodetic Survey) survey net established in 1968 and filed in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.
