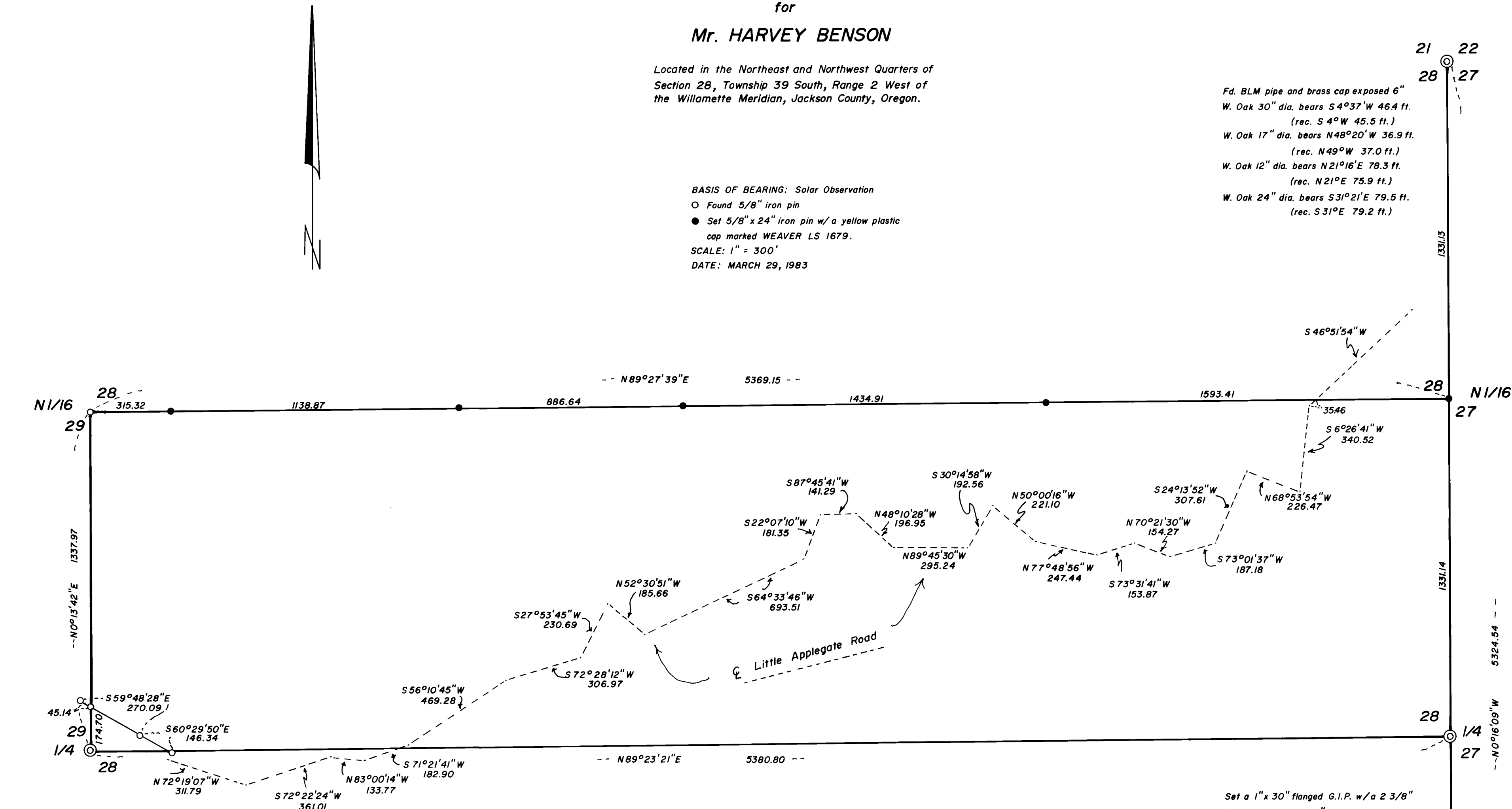

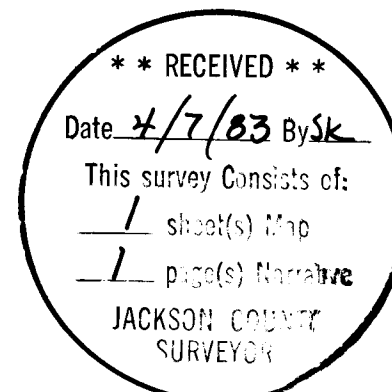
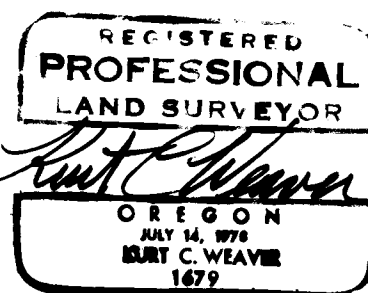

Location: Located in the Northeast and the Northwest
quarters of Section 28, Township 39 South,
Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian,
Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose: To locate the north line of the south half
of the north half of said Section 28, and
to locate the centerline of Little Applegate
County Road.

Procedure: The controlling corners were tied via a
series of closed traverses. The east
quarter corner was searched for extensively
prior to setting at proportionate position.
The monuments set along said north line
were set on ridge tops to facilitate further
surveying in the area. Bearing was based
on a solar observation.
