

PURPOSE:

To monument and describe two parcels approved for Minor Land Partition by the City of Ashland (see City Planning File No. MLP 83-13) being located in Lots 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 of Block 'K' of the recorded RAILROAD ADDITION to the Town of Ashland in the NE 1/4 of Sec. 9, T39SRIE, E.M.

Also located two power line easements to be dedicated to the City by this plat.

Also to locate a private sewer easemant over the existing sewer service from Parcel No. 2 across Parcel No. 1.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing a one-second theodolite and EDM equipment, the street center line monuments shown on the accompanying map were tied. No indication of iron monuments were found with a GA-32 Magnetic Locator at the center line intersections of "C" Street with Fourth and Fifth Streets.
