

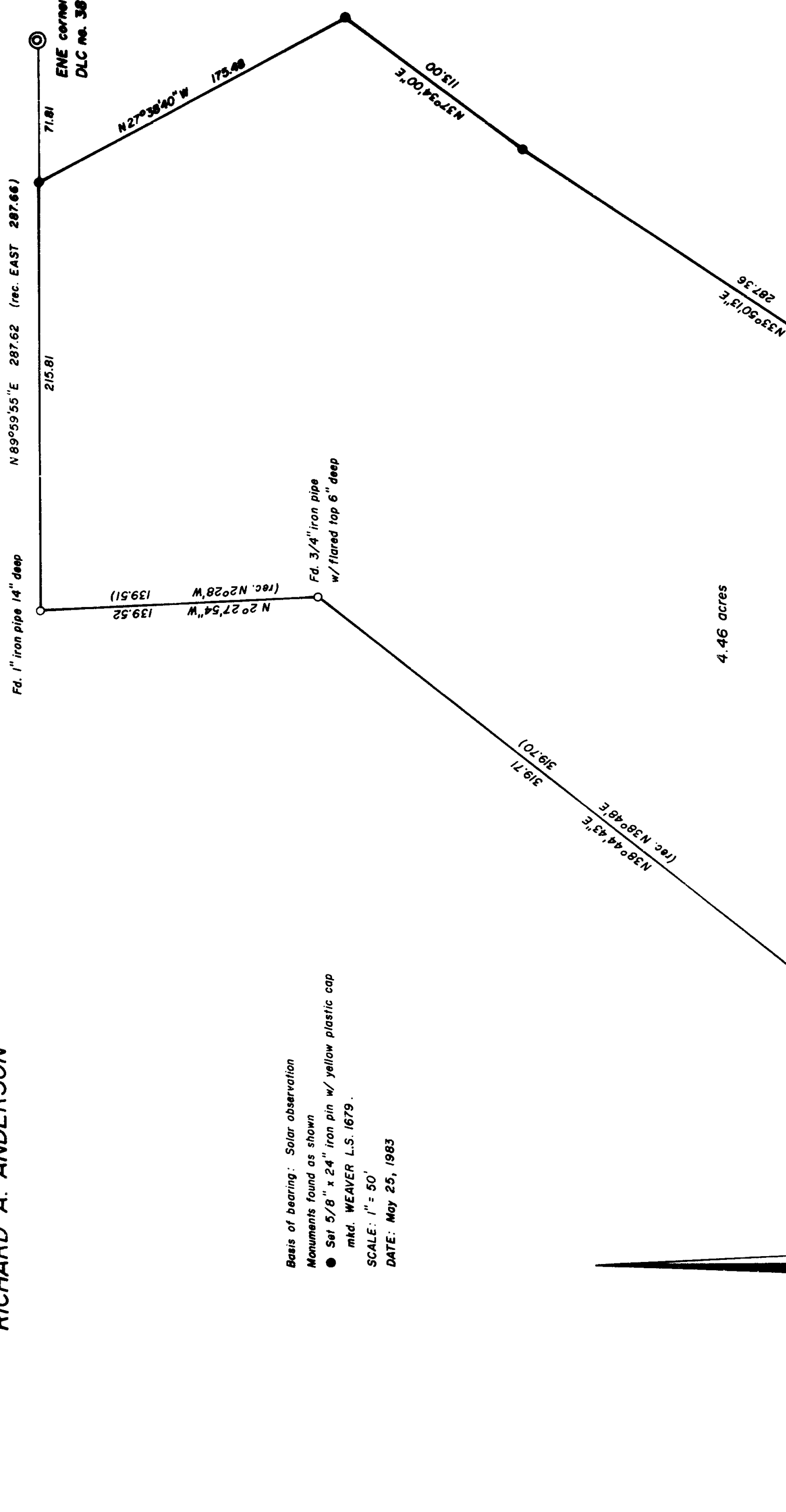
MAP OF SURVEY

Location: Located in the northeast quarter of Section 22, the northwest quarter of Section 23 and Donation Land Claim No. 38, all in Township 38 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose: To monument and describe a lot line adjustment, as well as retrace the existing property lines of the parcel shown on the accompanying map.

Procedure: Monuments recovered were incorporated in a closed traverse. The first three courses north of the highway on the east side of the parcel shown on the accompanying map constitute the adjusted boundary. The Highway right of way was determined as shown on the map. The station of the Humbug Creek bridge was acquired from the State Highway Department.
