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## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

LOCATION:

Situated in the Northeast quarter of Section 14, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and Meridian, Jackson County,

Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey, monument and partition into two (2) parcels, that tract of land as shown hereon, per clients request. Legal descriptions

were also prepared for these parcels.

PROCEDURE:

Found survey monuments per Recorded Survey Nos. 4847, 5330, 6598, 6905 and Interstate Highway No. 5. Other monuments found have an unknown origin. Survey No. 5330 was revised by this survey, inasmuch as a greater indepth title study was made, this time, in order to determine the chain of title. The railroad right of way controversy, concerning the right of way width each side of the centerline of the existing tracks, is still being tossed around. The existing recorded deeds indicate a right of way width of 50 feet each side of the centerline of said tracks. However, the Southern Pacific Railroad claims 100 feet each side of the centerline of said existing tracks. There has been two (2) court cases wherein Southern Pacific Railroad has found it necessary to sue the private landowner adjacent to their right of way and all cases reviewed by me, show that Southern Pacific Railroad has prevailed. Therefore, it seems reasonable to me that the right of way widths, as shown on the railroad maps, and claimed by Southern Pacific Rialroad, will probably prevail. This survey has monumented the right of way 100 feet from the centerline of the existing tracks. The client has been made aware of this situation. He has also contacted the title company, in regards to this right of way controversy, but apparently has not been given firm assurance that he does own undisputed title to within 50 feet of the centerline of said railroad tracks. There is a possible claim of adverse possession along the Westerly boundary of Parcel No. l and also a possible claim along the Northerly boundary line of Volume 309 page 375, which is contiguous to Parcel No. 2, as shown hereon. Other facts are as shown on the accompanying map.

## BASIS OF BEARING:

True Meridian at the N-S centerline of Section 14 as derived from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (formerly Coast and Geodetic Survey) survey net established in 1968 and filed in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.
