LOCATION:

Northeast quarter of Section 21, Township 36 South,

Range 4 West, W.M.

BASIS OF BEARING:

South line of Highway 99 as shown on Survey Nos. 1855

and 6846.

PROCEDURE:

The purpose of this survey was to establish a line for a boundary line agreement between Charles Schlumpberger and a County owned parcel. The purpose of showing the extension of right of way lines from survey nos. 1855 and 6846 is for drafting purpose only. The alignment as shown has commonly been accepted by local surveyors and closely agrees with the improvements.

Monument found, as shown on the southerly line of Highway, are 5/8 iron pins approximately 4 ins. deep.

The Northwest corner of Donation Land Claim 39; found a 2 ins. brass disk, marked and described according to official records.

At point "A", found a deed record corner being a 3/4 ins. iron pipe approximately 15 ins. deep. (Reference; see D.R. Vol. 216, Pg. 386).

Chord "B" was computed after running deed record to a theoretical point and adjusted to right of way now shown.

Monuments set being 5/8 ins. iron pins, 30 ins. long, set approximately flush with the ground.
