

Bruce & Pat Trowbridge Page Two

A 24 inch fir stump bears  $S68\frac{1}{2}^{O}W$ , 16.7 feet. (Survey #2116: 24 inch fir stump, S70W, 26 links).

A 12 inch cedar bears  $S39\frac{1}{2}^{O}E$ , 61.4 feet. (Survey #2116: 12 inch cedar,  $S39\frac{1}{4}^{O}E$ , 92 links).

A 14 inch madrone bears  $N41\frac{1}{2}^{O}W$ , 20.7 feet. (Survey #2116: 14 inch madrone,  $N41^{O}W$ , 31 links).

Measurements taken to center of trees at breast height, and to center of stumps.

#### NORTHEAST CORNER, SEC. 30

Found standard brass cap, with 5"X6"X12" granite stone alongside, set by Jackson County Surveyor's Office, Page 82, re-establishment notes.

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From the brass cap:

A 15 inch madrone with healed blazes bears record  $\mbox{N7}^{\rm O}\mbox{E, 37.6 feet.}$ 

A dead 14 inch fir with healed blazes bears S45°W, 74.0 feet. (County survey: 14 inch fir, S43°W, 73.4 feet).

A 6 inch oak with healed blazes bears record  $N61^{OW}$ , 25.0 feet.

Measurements to these first three trees taken to center of tree at breast height.

Measurement to next four trees, set in Survey #2116, taken to center of tree at lower blaze.

A 10 inch madrone bears N44°E, 48.5 feet. (Survey #2116: 8 inch madrone, N44°E, 74 links. County survey: 10 inch laurel, N44°E, 48.06 feet).

An 11 inch fir bears S76°E, 23.4 feet. (Survey #2116: 8 inch fir, S76°E, 35 links. County survey: 11 inch fir, S76°E, 23.1 feet).

A 14 inch madrone bears S19<sup>O</sup>W, 15.1 feet. (Survey #2116: 14 inch madrone, S19<sup>O</sup>W, 22 links. County survey: 14 inch laurel, S19<sup>O</sup>W, 14.52 feet).

A 12 inch fir bears  $N46^{O}W$ , 26.7 feet. (Survey #2116: 8 inch fir,  $N64^{O}W$ , 40 links. County survey: 12 inch fir,  $N46^{O}W$ , 26.4 feet).

# SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Bruce and Pat Trowbridge 6267 Coleman Creek Road Medford, Oregon 97501

LOCATION:

Situated in the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 30, Township 38 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian.

**PURPOSE:** 

To locate and monument that property described in recorded deed #76-16978, Jackson County Clerk's Office, Jackson County, Oregon.

NARRATIVE:

Basis of Bearings is the East line of the W½NE¼NE¼ Section 30, called North in the deed to the property. All traverses were closed. 5/8" iron rods set for property corners have yellow plastic caps imprinted "J. Ferguson 1943".

The 5/8" iron rods set on the West side of the property are 30 feet off the centerline of Coleman Creek Road as such centerline is defined in the deed recorded in Volume 428, Page 138, Jackson County Clerk's Office. Jackson County has no official deed or description for Coleman Creek Road; the above cited centerline description is consistently used in describing parcels of land in the W½NE¼NE¾ Section 30.

Found corners as follows:

# EAST & CORNER

Found  $1-\frac{1}{2}$  inch iron pipe with wood plug and shiner stamped "RS 404", set in Survey #2116, from which:

A 12 inch fir bears S  $14^{\circ}E$ , 6.5 feet. (Survey #2116: 10 inch fir, S1 $4^{\circ}E$ , 10 links).

A 12 inch fir bears  $N65^{O}W$ , 5.3 feet. (Survey #2116: 12 inch fir,  $N65^{O}W$ , 8 links).

Also found a 1/2 inch iron pipe  $N4^{\circ}58'E$ , 20.8 feet. (Survey #2116:  $N5^{\circ}E$ , 32 links).

Measurements taken to center of tree at breast height.

## CENTER OF SECTION

Found 5/8 inch iron rod set in Survey #6065, from which:

A 15 inch pine bears  $N3\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ , 134.0 feet. (Survey #6065: 15 inch pine,  $N3^{\circ}55^{\circ}E$ , 133.98 ft).

An 18 inch pine bears  $N85^{\circ}E$ , 129.0 feet. (Survey #6065: 18 inch pine,  $N85^{\circ}16^{\circ}E$ , 128.99 ft).

Also found a 3/4 inch iron pipe  $N48^{\circ}30$ 'E, 12.8 feet. (Survey #6065:  $N48^{\circ}56$ '57"E, 12.77 feet).

Measurements taken to center of tree at breast height.

## NORTH 1/2 CORNER

Found  $1-\frac{1}{2}$  inch iron pipe with wood plug and shiner stamped "RS 404", set in Survey #2116, from which:

A 26 inch fir stump bears N26<sup>O</sup>E, 7.5 feet. (Survey #2116: 26" fir stump, N26<sup>O</sup>E, 11 links).
