SURVEY NARRATIVE to comply with Paragraph 209.250, O.R.S.

PURPOSE:

To set the West 1/16 corner and determine the approximate location of the East line of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 4, Township 38 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon. Also to locate an existing driveway crossing said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter.

PROCEDURE:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of said Section 4, at which point I found a 1965 B.L.M. brass cap from which I found:

A Black Oak 32" diameter, South  $80^{\rm o}$  West 182 links A Fir 9" diameter, North 58° East 60 links

A White Oak 8" diameter, South 75° East 134 links A Madrone 22" diameter, South 73° West 69 links

A Fir 15" diameter, North 54° West 46 links

Thence I traversed North 89043'00" East 2662.08 feet to the North Quarter corner, at which point I found a 1980 County Surveyor brass cap from which I found:

A Madrone stump 12" diameter, South 2° East 10.0 feet

A Fir 7" diameter, North 20010' East 26.15 feet

A White Oak 6" diameter, South 70° East 41.16 feet

Thence I computed and set the West 1/16 corner and marked the approximate East line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter; thence I surveyed the existing driveways as shown on the map.

Meridian is based on the G.L.O. Survey of the North line of said Section 4.
