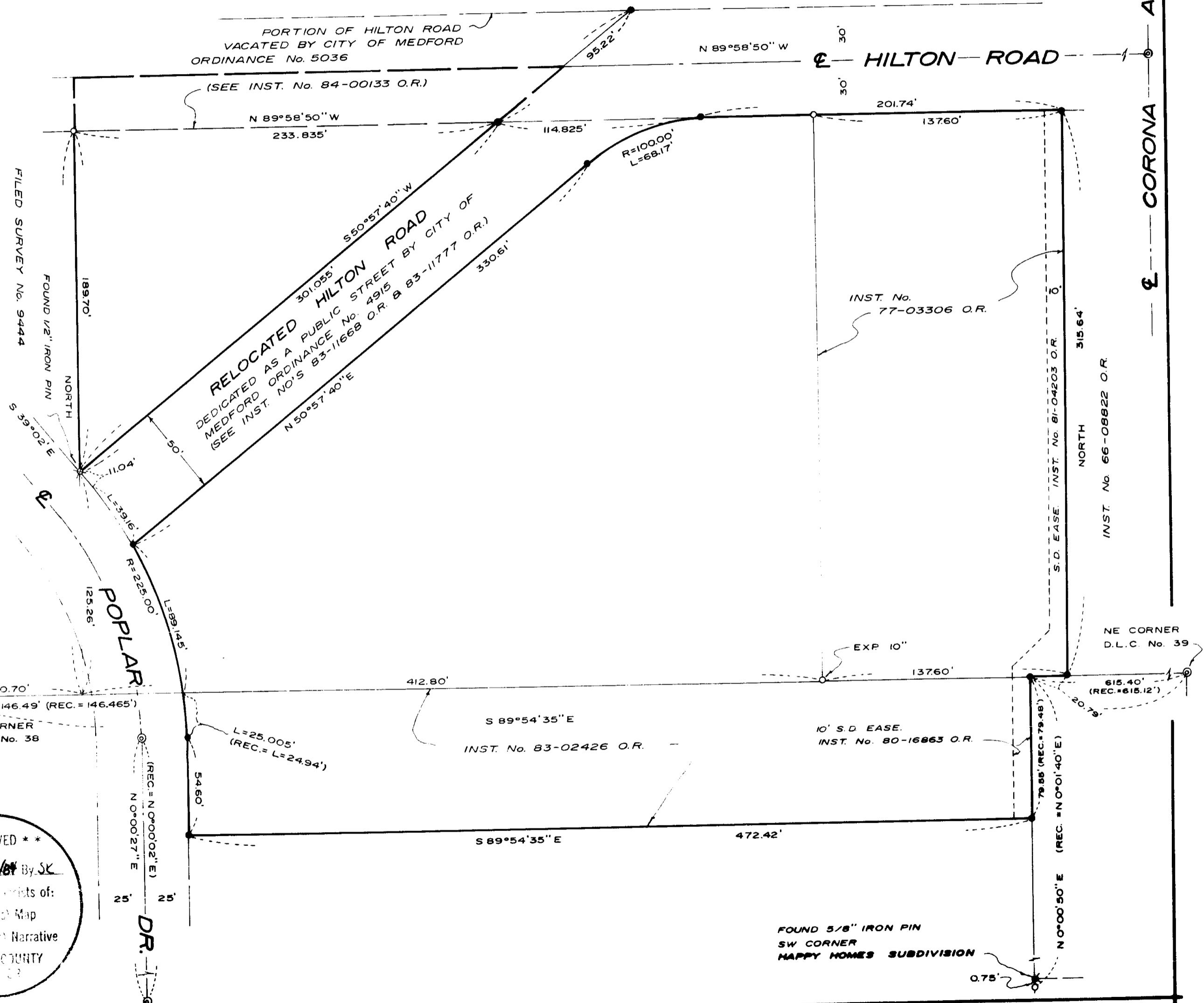

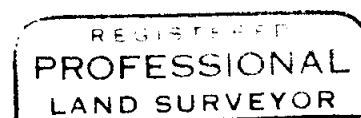
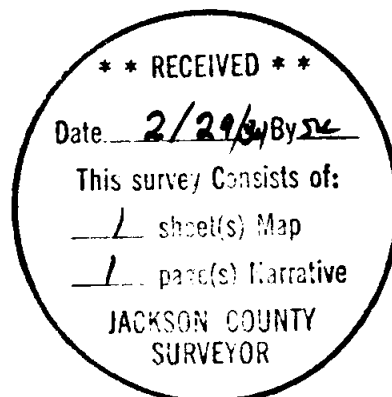
PURPOSE: To monument the right-of-way lines of relocated Hilton Road and two parcels to be included in POPLAR SQUARE, a proposed subdivision.

PROCEDURE: A one-second theodolite and EDM equipment were utilized to tie the controlling monuments indicated as found on the annexed map. From this control the desired parcels and the relocated road right-of-way lines were calculated and monumented.

The 3/4" iron pipe set for the Northwest corner of that tract described in Vol. 321, Page 119 D.R. on Filed Survey No. 3280 has been destroyed during construction of a stormdrain. This position was remonumented from found 3/4" iron pipe monuments set on said Survey No. 3280.

The West boundary of that tract described in Inst. No. 66-08822 O.R. was monumented at deed record position East of the SE corner of DLC No. 38.

Basis of bearings is Filed Survey No. 3280.
