CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Diagram This corner was originally established by U.S. Deputy T36S R3E Surveyor Rufus S. Moore under contract No. 475, Dated $\frac{1}{4} \frac{$26}{$35}$ July 3, 1883. This corner was subsequently remonumented from original evidence by the Bureau of Land Management, 1966 Division of Cadastral Surveys, in 1966.

Description of corner evidence found:

At the corner point I found a standard Bureau of Land Management brass cap monument marked as shown in the corner diagram. From which the following references:

- A 12-inch diameter cedar bears N45°00'E, 7.15 feet distance, with a healed blaze.
- A 15-inch diameter fir snag bears SO4°30'E, 45.60 feet distance, with a healed blaze.
- A 13-inch diameter dead and down fir, the root hole of which bears N44°30'W, 60.00 feet distance.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I establish the following new reference:

An 11-inch diameter fir bears S68°30'W, 50.00 feet distance, and scribed "1/4 S35 LS 1071 BT" on a double blaze.
