PURPOSE: To monument an adjusted boundary line as approved by the Jackson County Department of Planning and Development (see County Planning File No. 84-40-LLA) being located in the SW 1/4 of Section 33, T35SR3W, W.M.

Also to prepare a description of resultant Tax Lot 35 3W 33-800 and a resultant description of combined Tax Lots 35 3W 33-900 and 36 3W 4-405 in their adjusted configuration.
