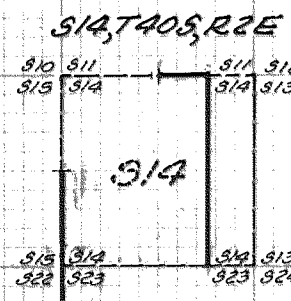

Root Crown of a 10" P. Pine - Wind Fall bears N26°50'E, 9.4 ft., (N28°E, 14 lks.), the Remains of the Wind Fall Scribed - E 1/16 S14 BT.
a Low 18" D. Fir Stump with a Healed Blaza bears S23°50'E, 18.8 ft., (S23°E, 23 lks.)

a 31" I. Cedar bears N33°40'W, 16.4 ft. (N33°W, 25 lks.) Blazed & Healed

Found - Standard B.L.M. Brass Cap & Iron Post with 2 inch Iron Pipe Along South Side (R.S. 404), 7 ft. West of a Barbed Wire Fence & Projecting 6 inches Above Ground
from which -
a 8" D. Fir snag bears N70°00'E, 9.4 ft. (N68°E, 13 lks.) Scribing Visible
a 11" D. Fir bears S74°45'E, 45 ft. (S73°E, 7 lks.) Blazed & Healed
a 13" D. Fir bears S77°00'W, 5.6 ft. (S76°W, 8 lks.) Blazed & Healed
a 9" D. Fir bears N33°30'W, 12.3 ft. (N37°W, 18 1/2 lks.) Blazed & Healed

Location: Section 14 and the NE 1/4 of Section 23, Township 40
South, Range 2 East, Willamette Meridian, in Jackson
County, Oregon.

Equipment: Wild T-16 and Wild DI-4

Date: June 18, 1984

Purpose: To mark the property lines between established corners,
as shown on the accompanying map of survey.

Procedures: In 1968, the BLM set by proportionate measurement, the
North 1/16th section corner between Sections 22 and 23,
the 1/4th section corner between Sections 14 and 15,
the East 1/16th section corner between section 14 and 23,
the East 1/16th section corner between sections 11 and 14
and the 1/4th section corner between sections 11 and 14.
In 1972, Robert M. Thompson as shown in filed survey
number 5064, Jackson County Surveyor's Office, set the
Southeast 1/16th, the Center-East 1/16th and the Northeast
1/16th section corner of section 14. The above corners
were all set using the procedures as outlined in the 1947
BLM Manual for the Survey of Public Lands, and exceed the
minimum error of closures in the 1947 BLM Manual. I
therefore accepted these corner monuments as being the
corner positions.

Bearings are based on solar observations taken at the lo-
cations shown on the accompanying map of survey. True
line between the corners was established by offsets from a
random traverse line.

The property lines were blazed with quarter blazes 3 feet
on either side of the true line, and tagged with 1 1/2" X
5" aluminum tags 1 foot either side of the true line.
The blazes were painted with red tree marking paint.

NOTE: This record of survey consists of a 1 page narrative
and a 1 page map of survey(18"X 24").
