


Survey Narrative Lloyd R. Gerritsen Page Two July 2, 1984

The boundaries of those parcels partitioned by Luther G. Blake out of that tract described in Vol. 76, Page 309 Misc. Records were positioned by giving priority to senior deeds (note the original conveyance dates on the annexed map).

Witness corners were set for the SE and NE corners of the subject tract per an agreement with the client.

LOCATION: Located in the NW 1/4 of Section 30, T36SR2W, W.M., Jackson County, Oregon

BASIS OF BEARINGS: Filed Survey No. 4596

PURPOSE: To monument that parcel described in Inst. No. 72-15936 O.R., being the last parcel conveyed out of the original Luther G. Blake tract as described in Vol. 76, Page 309 Misc. Records.

PROCEDURE: Existing monumentation controlling the Blackwell Road right-of-way and the boundaries of that tract conveyed from Louie Loeffler to Vivian Norman Barto by Deed Volume 280, Page 373 were established by Surveyor C. Z. Boyden on surveys in 1940 and 1946.

The East boundary of that tract described in Volume 336, Page 445 Deed Records was established on Filed Survey No. 7599 midway between the East and West boundaries of said tract described in Volume 280, Page 373 Deed Records by bisecting the South boundary as directed in the deed and running North on a bearing split of the East and West boundaries. The West boundary of that tract described in Volume 336, Page 445 Deed Records was established on this survey using the same procedure, bisecting the distances on the West-half of the South boundary of said tract described in Volume 280, Page 373 and running North on a split of the bearings of said West-half.

The South boundary of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 30 was calculated from records of previous surveys (see Filed Survey No. 2651).
