Description: - From a monument at the intersection of Second Street West and Oleson Street in the City of Medford, Oregon, run 50° 22' W 25 feet, thence West 143 1/2 feet, parallel to center line of said Street West to a 3 inch gas pipe of the point of beginning, run thence West 287 feet, thence 50° 32' W 82 1/2 feet, thence East 287 feet, thence N 0° 32' E 82 1/2 feet to the point of beginning.

Dedication: - Know all men by these presents that we, William Erdman and Ernestine Erdman (his wife) are the owners in fee simple of the above described tract of land and that we have laid out the same in lots, blocks, streets and alleys, and we do hereby dedicate to the public for use as Highways all streets and alleys shown hereon and we hereby name and designate the above described tract as the CRESCENT SUBDIVISION.

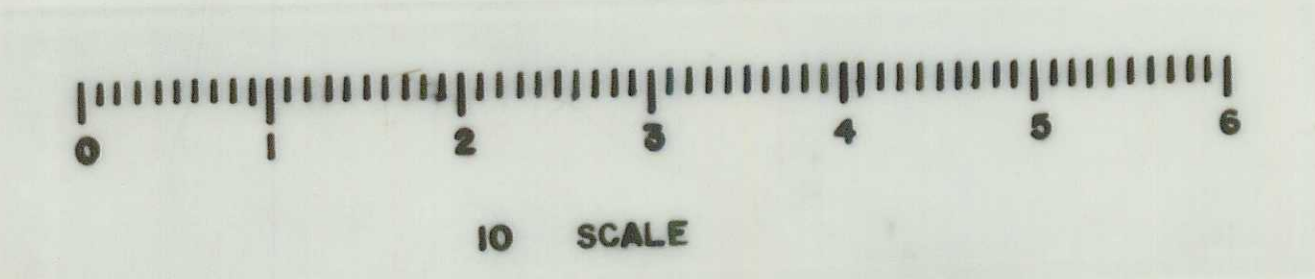
