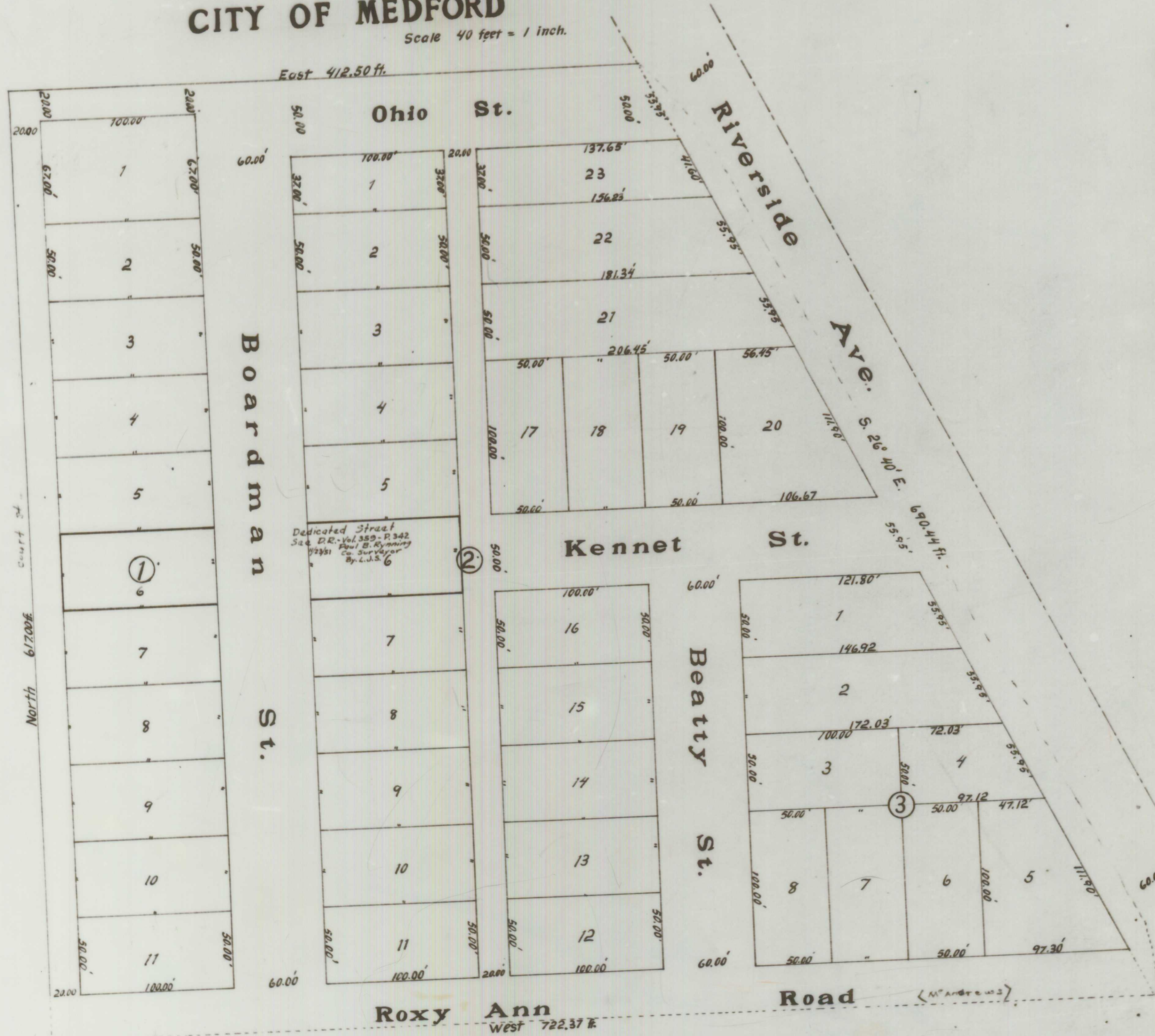


PALMS SECOND ADDITION to the CITY OF MEDFORD

DESCRIPTION
Beginning at the Sw. corner of D.L.C. No 61 in Township 37 South of Range 2 west of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence North 617.00 feet; thence East 412 feet to the West side of Riverside Ave.; thence South 26° 40' East 690.44 feet along said avenue to the center of Roxy Ann Road; thence West 722.37 feet to the place of commencing.

DEDICATION
Know all men by these Presents that we C.W Palm and Callie Palm, his wife, are the owners in fee simple of the above described land: that we have laid out the same into Lots, Blocks, Streets and Alleys as shown by the Map hereon, and that said map is a correct representation of said survey and subdivision, and we do hereby dedicate to the Public, for Public Highways all the Streets and Alleys shown on said tract, and do hereby designate and name the said tract as shown hereon as Palms Second Addition to the City of Medford, State of Oregon.
