Commencing at the Quarter Section Corner common to Sections 25 and 26 Township 37 South Range 2 West W.M., and running thence Easterly along the North line of the Jacksonville Road 363.6 ft., and 60 ft South to the place of beginning; thence running South 1130.25 ft, thence East 454.8 ft, thence North 1134.9 ft, thence Westerly along the South line of the Jacksonville Road 454.3 ft. to the place of beginning, all of which is outside of the City Limits of Medford, Oregon.
