



DESCRIPTION- Beginning at the South-east corner of Donation Land Claim No 54 in Township 37 South of Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian and running thence N 89° 54' W 4950.4 feet, thence North 2628.4 feet to a point on the South Corporation boundary of the town of Central Point, thence East along said boundary and County road 4950.4 feet to the center of the County road running North and South thence South along the center of the last named road 2632.7 feet to the point of beginning.
