Description:— Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Highland Park Add to the City of Medford, (at a 3' gaspipe monument there planted) run thence North on the center line of Washington Street 11422 feet to the South line of Main St West; thence N89°42' E on said South line 330 feet; thence South 180 feet; thence N89°42' E 161.94 feet; thence South 107540 feet to a stone; thence West 27574 feet; thence North 11112 feet to a gaspipe monument; thence West 216.2 feet to the point of beginning.

Dedication: Know all men by these presents that I, W.E. Weaver, the owner in fee simple of the above described tract of land and that I have laid out the same into Lots, Blocks, Streets and Alleys, and I do hereby dedicate to the Public for use as highways all the Streets and Alleys shown hereon; and that the map hereon is a correct representation of said survey; and I do hereby name and designate this plat as the **OAK GROVE SUBDIVISION**, Medford, Oregon.

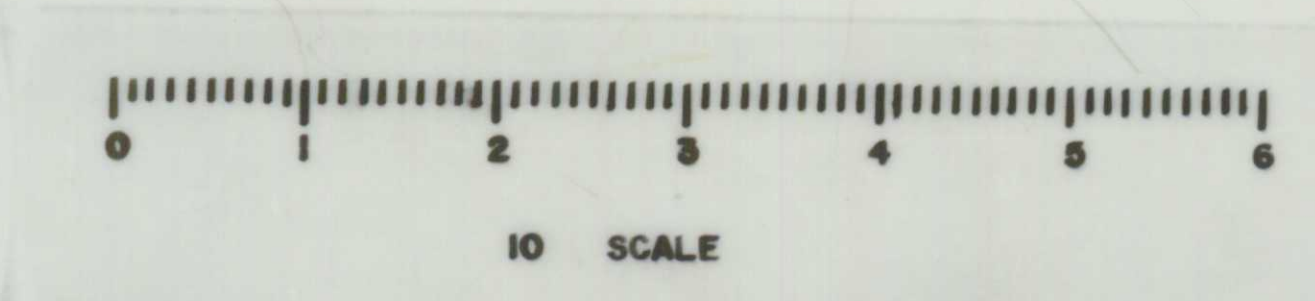
