


CLOVERDALE ADDITION

Description.

This Subdivision lies wholly within the boundaries of the South 1/4 of Lot 2, Block 4 Barr's Addition described as follows:
Beginning at a stone set 625.12 ft. North of an Iron pin on the Center of Dakota Street and the East line of Hamilton Street; thence South 89° 59' 40" East 660 ft. to the Westline of Peach Street; thence North on said line 165.19 ft. thence West 660 ft. to the East line of Hamilton Street; thence South on said line 165.12 ft. to the point of beginning.
