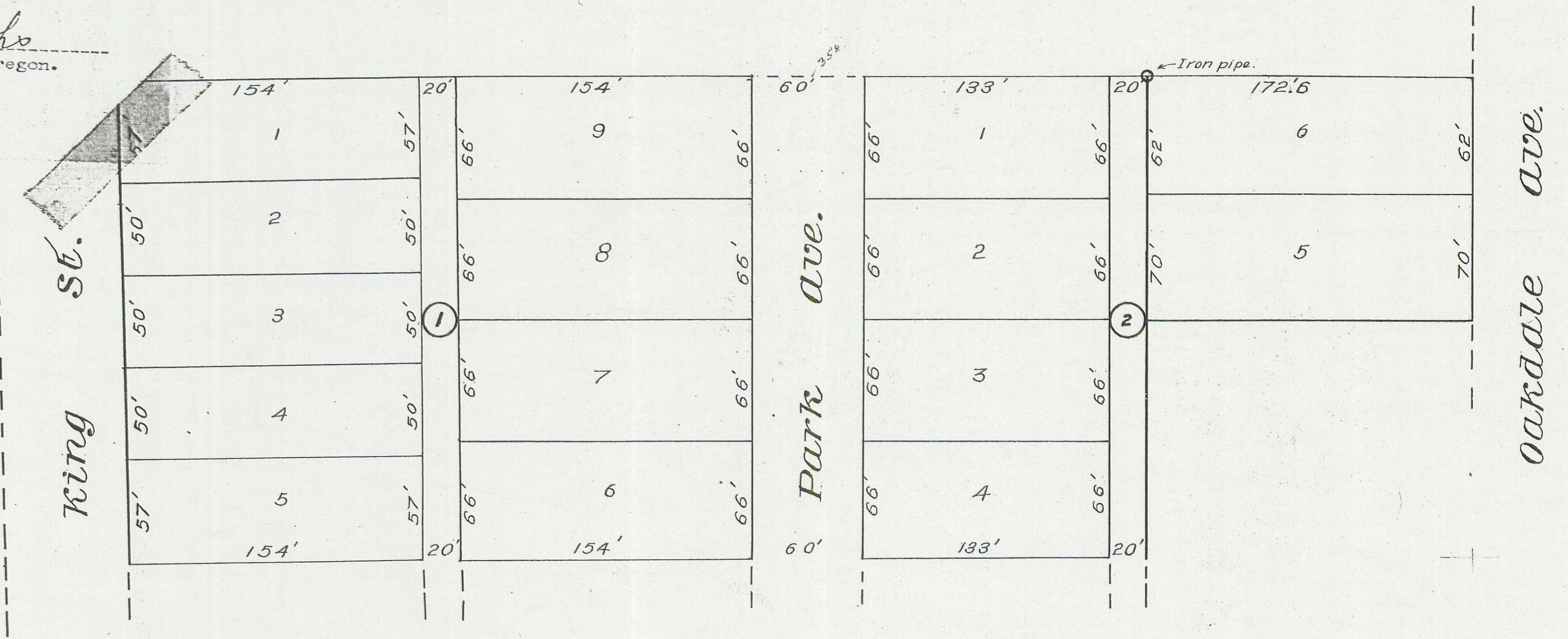

and running thence, West 713 feet; thence, South on the East line of King St. 264
feet; thence East on the North line of Tuttle's Addition, 541 feet; thence North
132 feet; thence East, 172.82 feet; thence, North, on the West line of Oakdale Ave.
132 feet, to the place of beginning, all of which is in block 1 lots Barr's Addition.
