SURVEYOR'S AFFIDAVIT AND DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARY.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that I, H.G. Butterfield did on May 27 1910 correctly survey and mark with proper monuments the land as shown by map hereon that said map is a correct representation of said survey as made by me on the ground, and that I planted a 2 in. galvanized Iron pipe 3 ft. long 6 inches below the surface of the ground at a point in the South line of Ashland St. City of Ashland, Jackson County, State of Oregon, 30 feet South 0° 12' West of and S. 89° 48' E. 1320 ft. from Section Corner Common to Sections 9, 10, 15, and 16 for place of beginning; thence for outside boundary of said land S. 0° 12' W. 1290 ft. thence N 89° 48' W. 610.5 ft. thence N. 0° 12' E. 1320 ft. to center of Ashland St., thence S. 89° 48' E. 610.5 ft. along center of Ashland St. thence S. 0° 12' W. 30 ft. to place of beginning, except a tract 140.5 feet wide and 330 ft. deep out of the N.E. corner of above and running S. 0° 12' W. 300 ft. from above place of beginning. This land is the E. 1/2 of NW. 1/4 of NW. 1/4 Section 15, T. 39 S. R. 1 E. W. M. Oregon.
