DESCRIPTION: Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 1 in Block 4 Barrs Addition to the City of Medford, Oregon, run thence East parallel to, and 20 feet South of the center line of Eleventh St West 658.7 feet to the west line of Peach St. (produced); thence 50°01'E on the west line of Peach St 331.55 feet to the center line of Twelfth St West (extended); thence 58°58'W along the center line of Twelfth St 658.52 feet to the east line of Hamilton St; thence N0°03'W 331.93 feet to the place of beginning; said tract being Lot 1 of Block 4 in Barrs Add to Medford.
