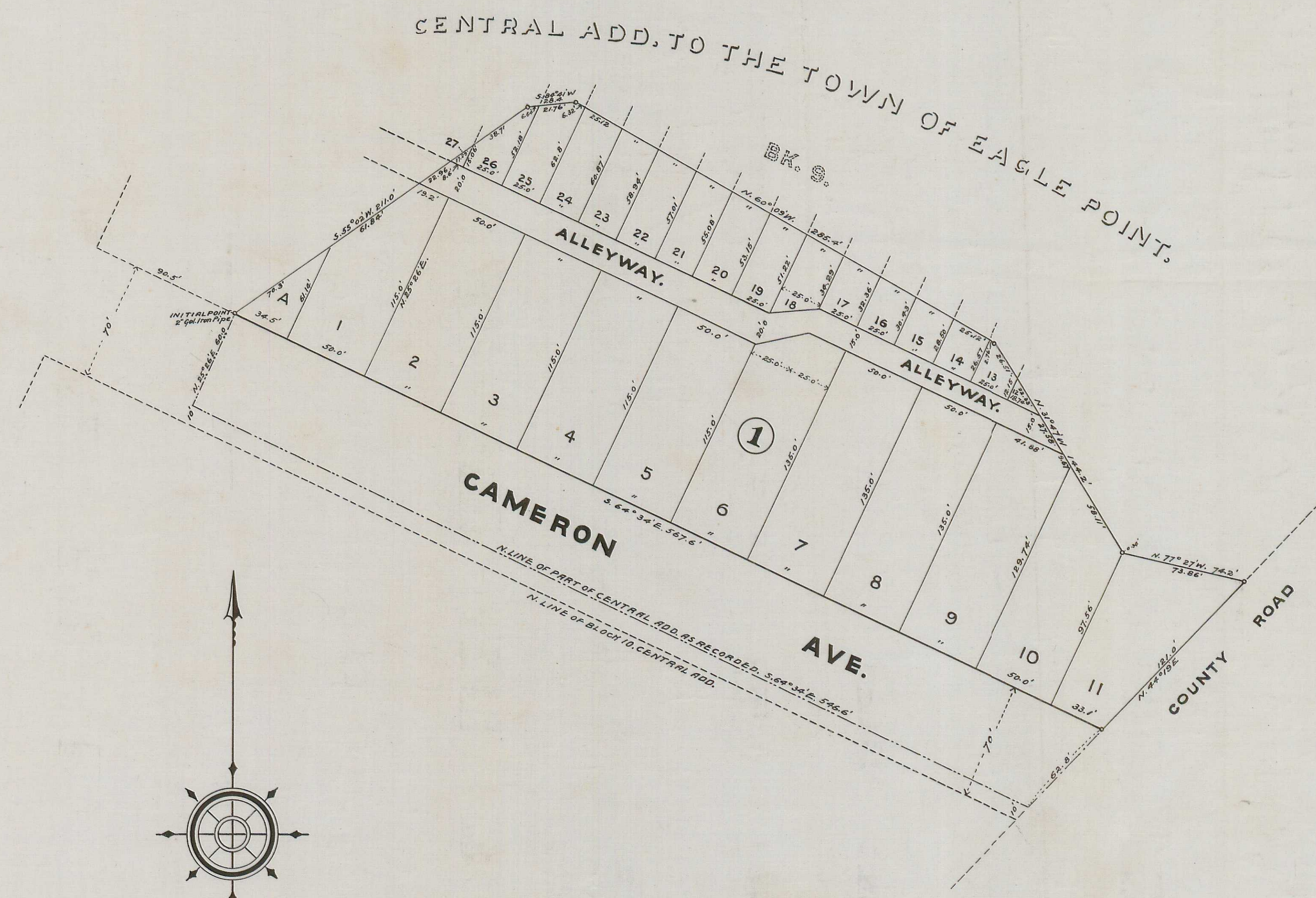

DESCRIPTION: Commencing at the N. E. corner of D. L. C. N^o. 45 in T. 36 S. R. 1 W. Will. Mer. and running thence S. 89° 58' W. 1409.1 feet; thence S. 19° 22' W. 1135.7 feet; and S. 64° 34' E. 617.5 feet to the place of beginning; thence S. 64° 34' E. 567.6 feet; thence N. 44° 19' E. 121.0 feet; thence N. 77° 27' W. 74.2 feet; thence N. 31° 41' W. 144.2 feet; thence N. 60° 09' W. 285.4 feet; thence S. 84° 41' W. 28.4 feet; thence S. 55° 02' W. 211.0 feet to the place of beginning.
