DESCRIPTION. Beginning at a point marked by a cross (X) on a sandstone 18x17x16 ins, set 12 ins under the ground, from which the Southwest corner of the Levi A. Rice Donation Land Claim No. 59, in Township No. 37 South, Range No. 2 West of the Willamette Meridian bears South 1565.60 feet, and running thence North 607.86 feet on the West boundary of said claim No. 59, thence East 855.80 feet to the center of the County Road, thence S 28° 43' E 688.40 feet along the center of the County Road, thence West 583.30 feet; thence South 7.59 feet; thence West 601.26 feet to the place of beginning.

DEDICATION. Know all men by these presents that we, Albert Clifton Taylor and Irma Taylor, husband and wife, of Jackson County, State of Oregon, are the owners in fee simple of the above described tract of land; that we have laid out the same into Lots and Roads, as shown by the map hereon, and that said map is a correct representation of the survey and subdivision, and that we do hereby dedicate to the Public, for Public highways, all of the roads as shown on said tract, and we do hereby designate and name the said tract as shown hereon as the MACE SUBDIVISIONS.

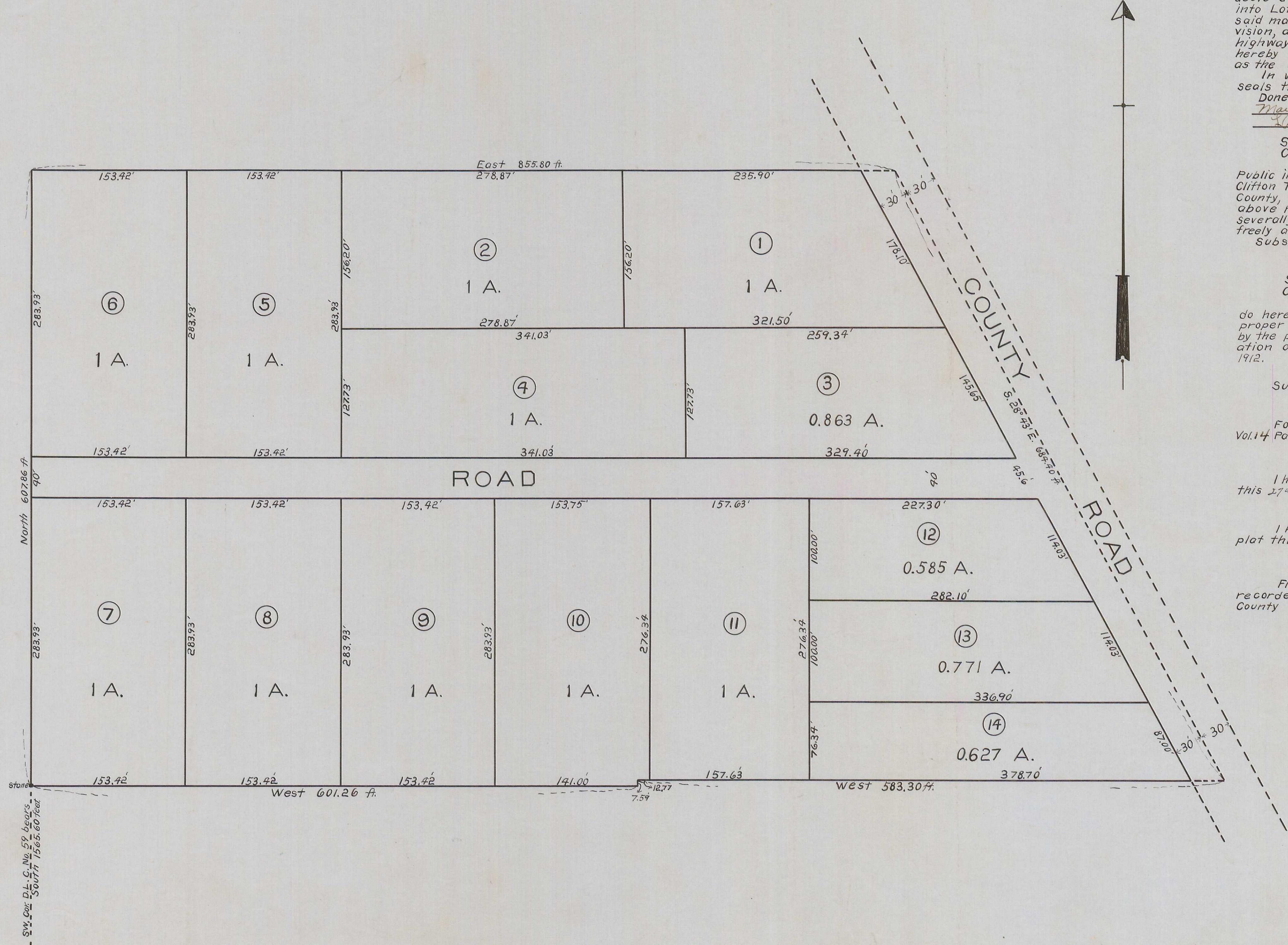
