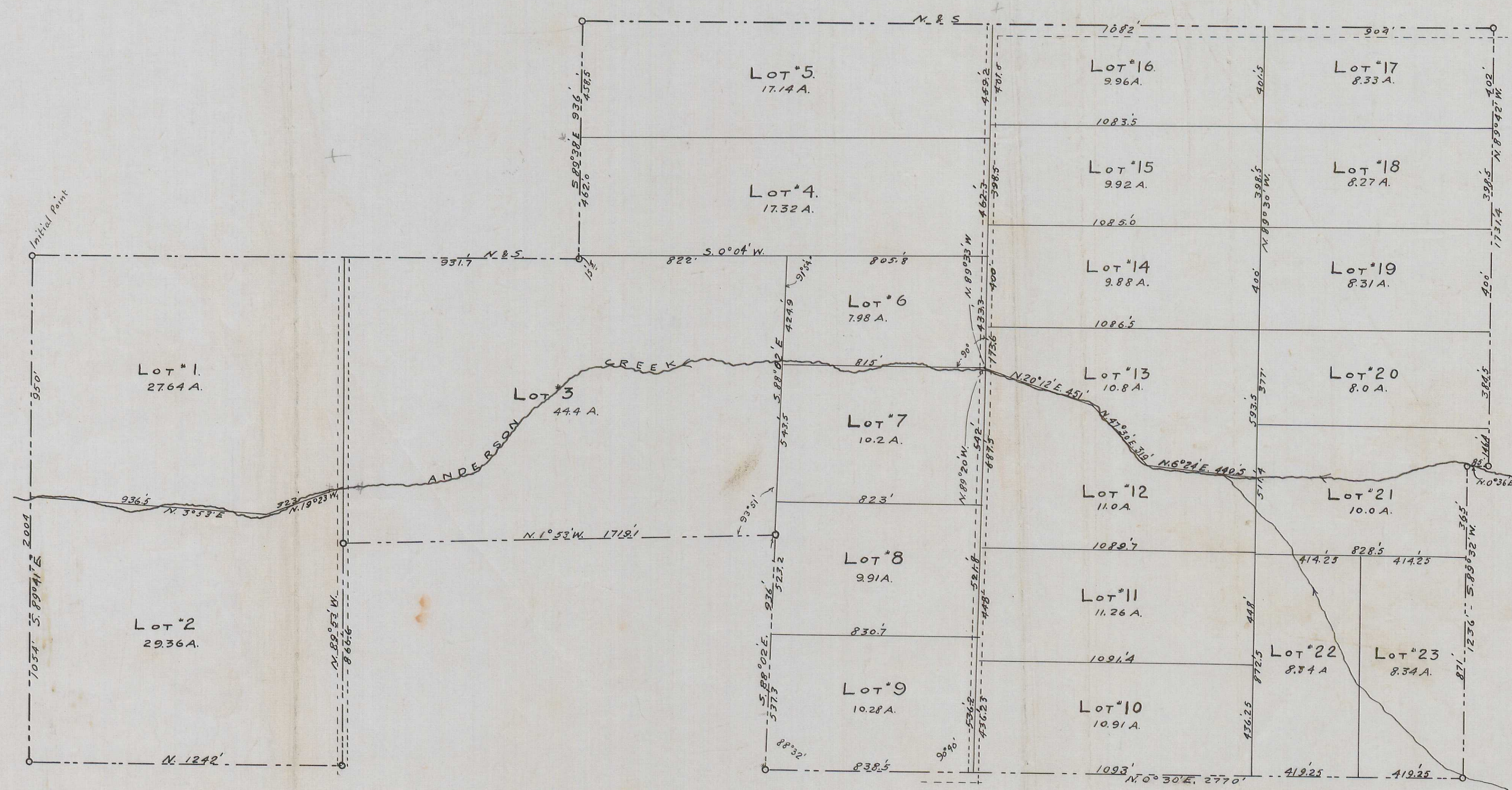

SURVEYORS AFFIDAVIT AND DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARY.
THIS IS TO CERTIFY THAT I P.D. Blackden did on Feb. 29 to Mch 2, 1912 correctly survey the lands as shown by map hereon, being part of D.L.C. #61, all of D.L.C. #62 and Lots #1-2 and 3 in Sec #27 and Lot #3 in Sec #22, all being in Tp 38 South, Range 1 West of Willamette Meridian, Oregon, Jackson County.
Said map is a correct representation of said survey made by me, and said survey is tied into the N.E. Corner of D.L.C. #62
The outside boundary of this tract is described as follows; Beginning at the N.E. Cor. of D.L.C. #62, thence South 2166.7 ft., thence S. 89°38'E 936 ft., thence South 3620 ft., thence N. 89°42' W. 1731.4 ft., thence N. 0°36'E 85 ft., thence S 89°32' W. 1236 ft., thence N. 0°36' E. 2770 ft., thence S. 88°02' E. 936 ft., thence N. 1°53' W. 1719.1 ft., thence N. 89°33' W. 866.6 ft., thence North 1242 ft., thence S. 89°41' E. 2004 ft. to the place of beginning.
