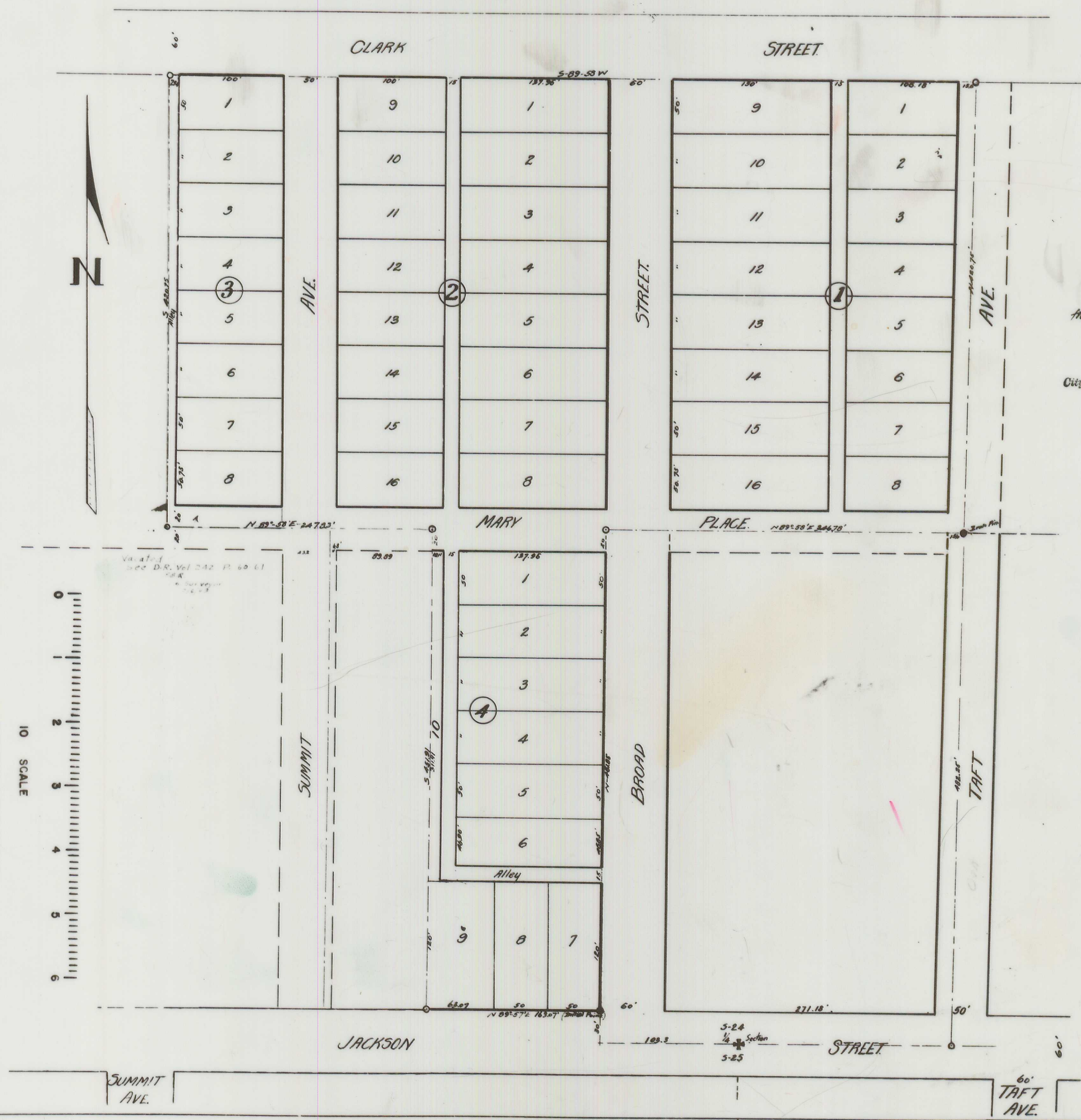


# MARY PLACE ADD. TO THE CITY OF MEDFORD.

**-DESCRIPTION-**  
Beginning at a point 103.3 ft west and 30' North of the 1/4 Section Stone between S. 24 and S. 25, T. 37 S. R. 2 W., W. 1/4, Thence North 451.85 ft; thence N 89° 58' E, 346.78 ft. to an Iron Pin which is 156' East of the West line of Taft Ave; thence North on a line parallel to said West line of Taft Ave 420.75' to the South line of Clark Street; thence South 5 09° 58' W 157.68 ft on said South line of Clark Street; thence South 420.75 ft; thence N 89° 58' E 247.83 ft; thence South 451.91' to the north line of Jackson St; thence N 89° 57' E along said North line of Jackson St 163.07' to the point of Beginning.
