


ROYAL ORCHARD TRACT NO. 2

DESCRIPTION: Beginning at the sec. corner for sections 13, 18, 19 and 24 in Township 38 South, Ranges 1 and 2 West, of Willamette Meridian, and running thence N. $89^{\circ} 08' E.$ 2208.35 ft. to west side of County road; thence S. $28^{\circ} 51' W.$ 876.03 ft. along west side of said road; thence S. $59^{\circ} 05' W.$ 115.17 ft.; thence S. $2^{\circ} 12' W.$ 174.30 ft.; thence S. $34^{\circ} 31' W.$ 185.70 ft.; thence S. $15^{\circ} 32' W.$ 353.12 ft.; thence S. $40^{\circ} 40' W.$ 66.00 ft.; to end of County road; thence S. $0^{\circ} 27' W.$ 1124.80 ft.; thence S. $89^{\circ} 18' W.$ 1423.00 ft. to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. Secs. 19 and 24; thence S. $89^{\circ} 50' W.$ 1331.73 ft.; thence N. $0^{\circ} 04' W.$ 1327.50 ft.; thence N. $89^{\circ} 57' E.$ 1330.28 ft.; thence N. $0^{\circ} 08' W.$ 1326.55 ft. to place of beginning, and containing 140.35 acres.
