Commencing at the Section Corner common to sections 19, 20, 29 & 30, Township 37 South Range 1 West W.M. and running thence West on south line of Section 19, 1828.94 ft. thence North 0°05' East, 1247.0 ft. to the East N.E. Corner of D.L.C. #42; thence North 21°19' East, 838.8 ft.; thence South 89°42' East, 1788.7 feet, to section line; thence South 0°21' East, 1320 ft to place of beginning.

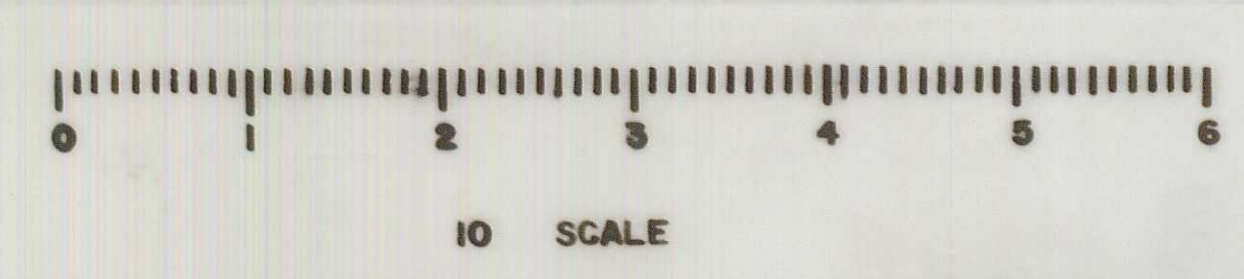
