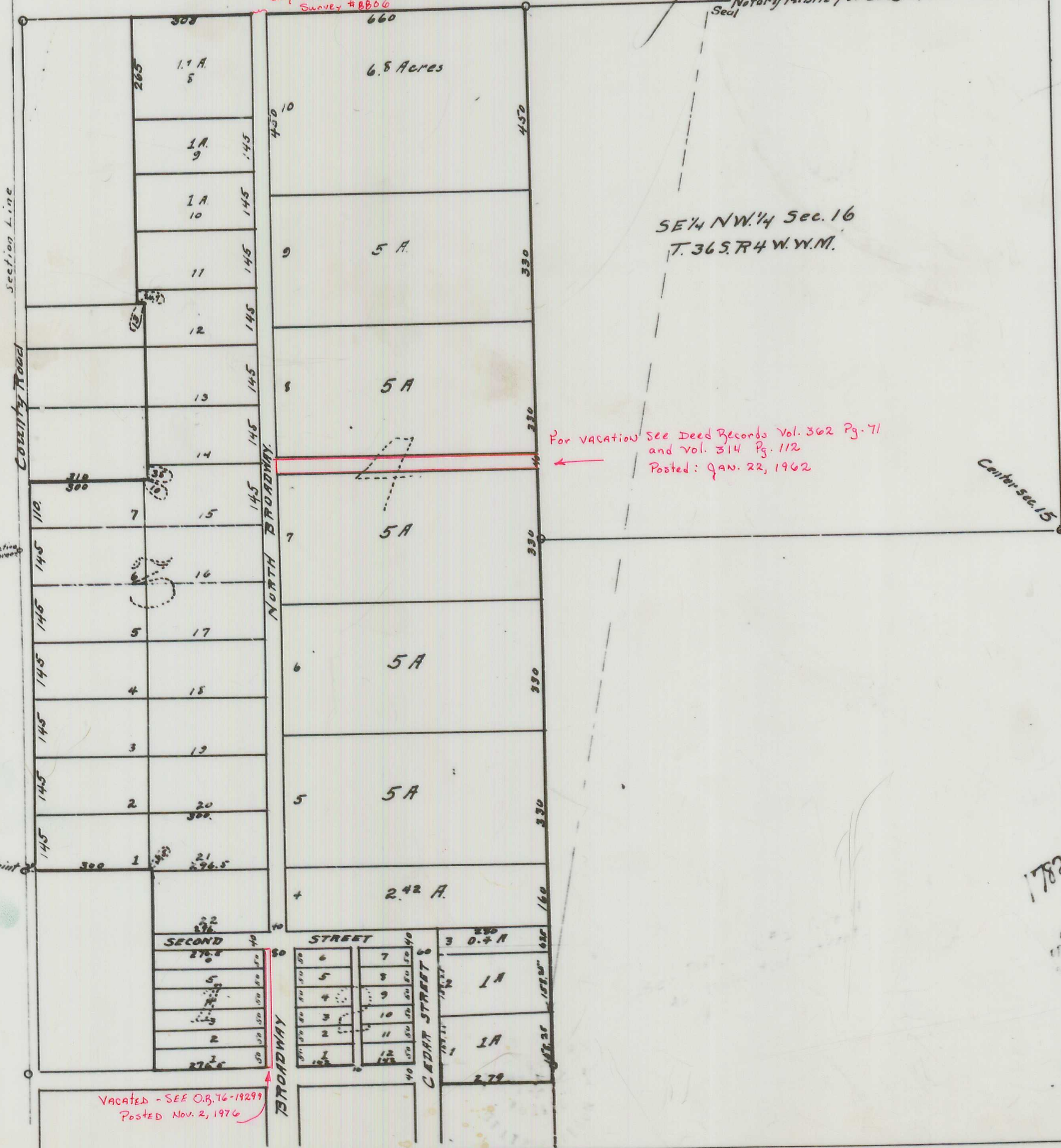

AFFIDAVIT of Surveyor
 I, F. E. Hobson, being first duly sworn, depose and say, that at the request of G. H. Carner and Geo. C. Sabins, I did on the 4th day of April, 1911, at the place therein described, survey and plat the within described land, and the West 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 15, T. 36 S. R. 4 W. W.M. Beginning at an iron stake 2 inches in diameter and driven 18 inches into the ground from which the section corner of sections 15-16-21-22, T. 36 S. R. 4 W. W.M. is 200 feet, thence North 78.0 feet, thence East 330 feet, thence North 423.5 feet, thence West 13 feet, thence North 726 feet, thence East 100 feet, thence South 2680 feet, thence West 320 feet, thence North 40 feet, thence West 716.5 feet, thence North 501.5 feet, thence West 320 feet, to place of beginning.
 That subsequent to said survey, I drafted the within map, upon a scale of 200 feet to an inch to indicate the actual survey as made and to designate the land as now subdivided and prepared for approval.
 That blocks are numbered from 1 to 4 inclusive and widths and lengths of lots are as represented hereon.
