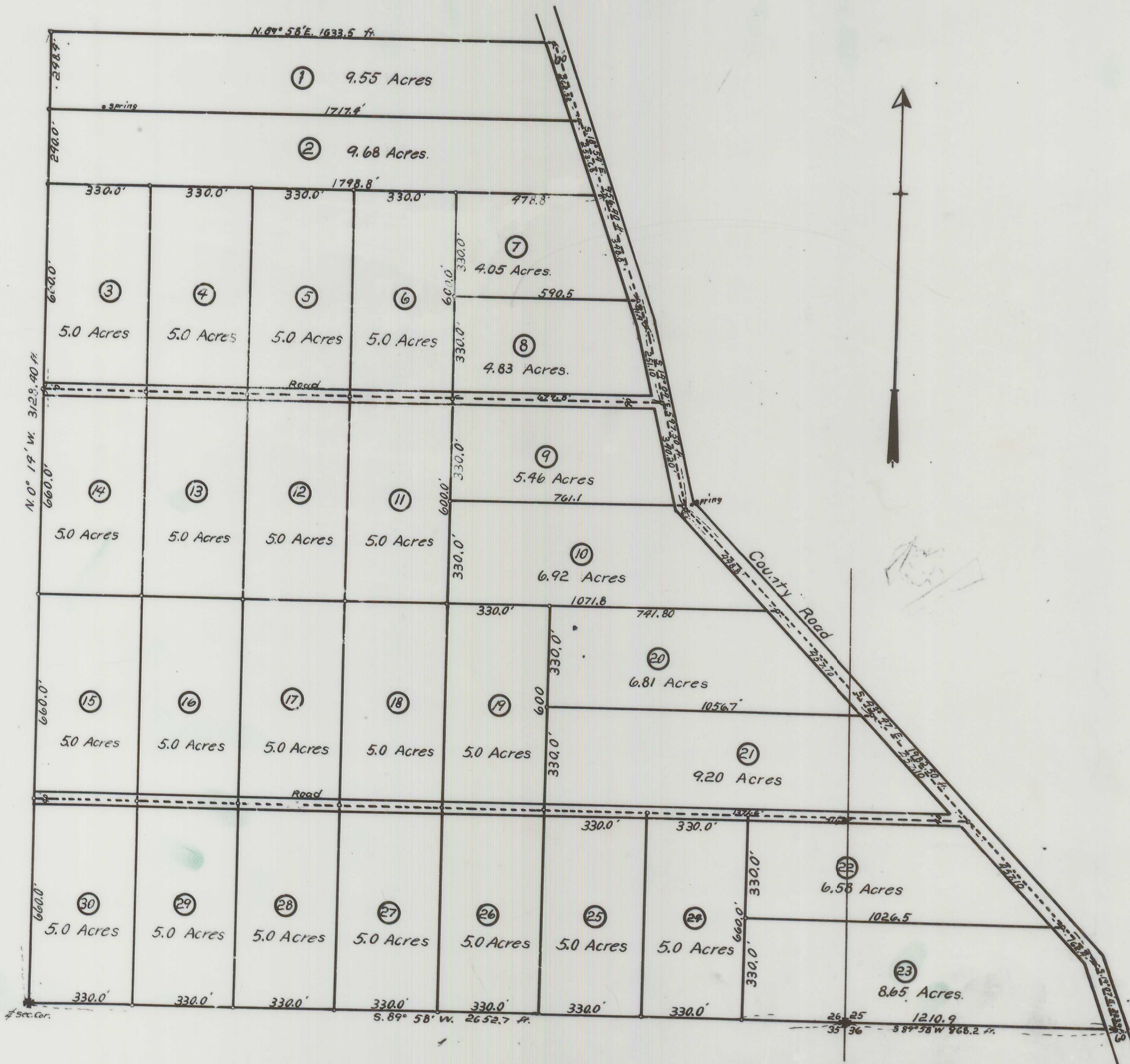


LIVE OAK ORCHARD TRACTS

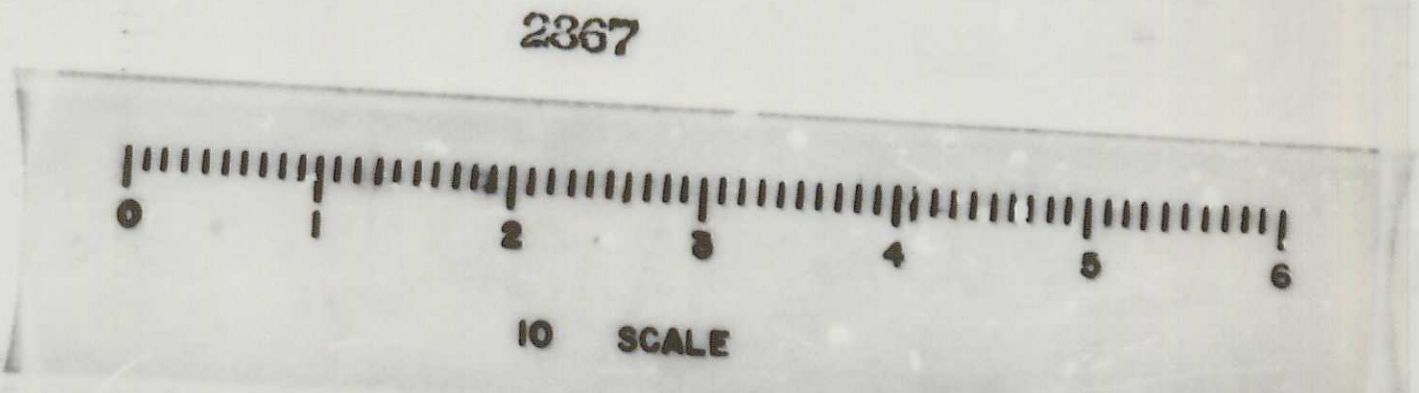
DESCRIPTION
Beginning at the corner of sections 25, 26, 35 and 36, in Township No. 35 South, Range No. 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, marked by cross on stone 13x9x7 ins, set 6 ins below the surface of the ground, and running thence S. 89° 58' W. 2652.7 feet to the 1/2 sec cor on the South side of Section 26; thence N. 0° 12' W. 3128.90 feet; thence N. 89° 58' E. 1633.5 feet to the center of the county road; thence S. 18° 59' E. 756.90 feet along center of County road; thence S. 19° 07' E. 597.5 feet; thence S. 43° 47' E. 1982.5 feet; thence S. 19° 07' E. 223.9 feet to line between Sections 25 and 36; thence S. 89° 58' W. 868.2 feet to the place of beginning, containing 171.73 Acres.

DEDICATION
Know all men by these presents that I, James D. Keifer, a single man, of Los Angeles County, State of California, am the owner in fee simple of the above described tract of land; that I have laid out the same into Tracts and roads, as shown by the map hereon, and that said map is a correct representation of the survey and subdivision, and that I do hereby dedicate to the Public, for Public Highways, all the roads shown on said tract, and I do hereby designate and name the said tract as shown hereon as LIVE OAK ORCHARD TRACTS, Jackson County, State of Oregon.
