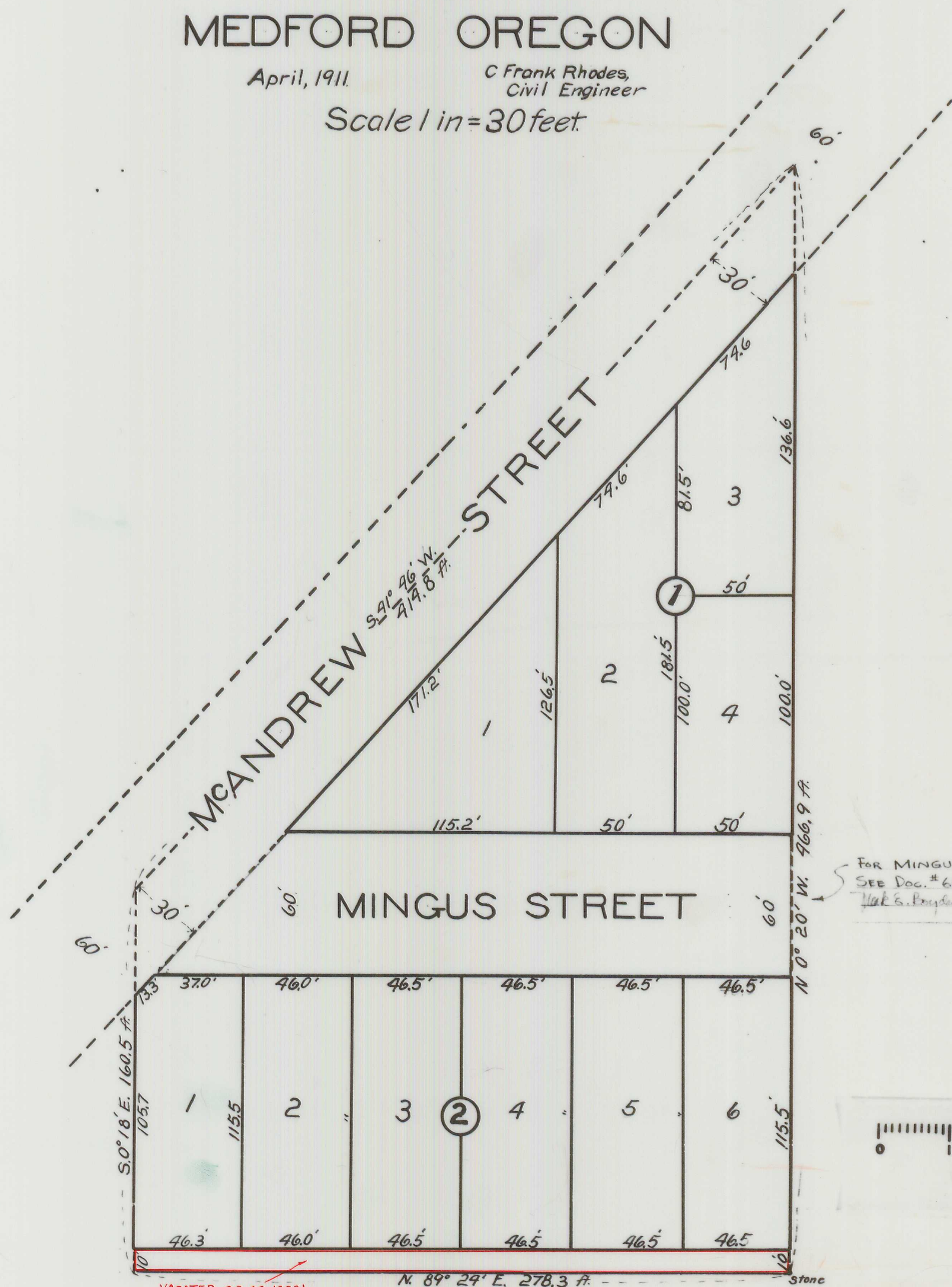

DESCRIPTION: Beginning at a point marked by a cross on a stone 14x9x8 ins, set 6 ins. below the surface of the ground, from which the 1/4 sec. corner between sections 24 and 25, in Township 37 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian bears S. 20° 24' E. 1305.2 feet, and running thence N. 0° 20' W. 466.9 feet, thence S. 41° 46' W. 414.8 feet, thence S. 0° 16' E. 160.5 feet, thence N. 89° 24' E. 278.3 feet to the place of beginning.

DEDICATION: Know all men by these presents that we, D.S. Wood and Augusta B. Wood, husband and wife, of Jackson County, State of Oregon, are the owners in fee simple of the above described tract of land; that we have laid out the same into Blocks, Lots, Streets and Alleys, as shown by the map hereon, and that said map is a correct representation of the survey and subdivision, and that we do hereby dedicate to the Public, for public highways, all the Streets and Alleys shown on said tract, and we do hereby designate and name the said tract as shown hereon as WOOD'S ADDITION to Medford Oregon. 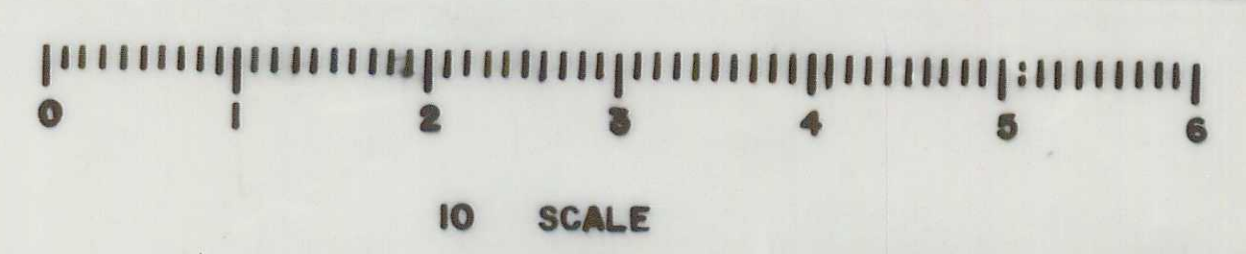
