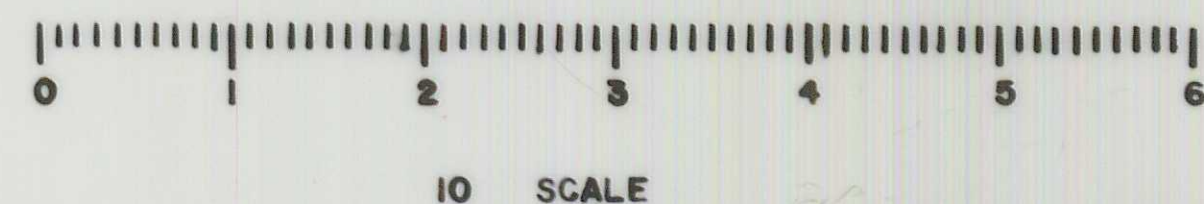
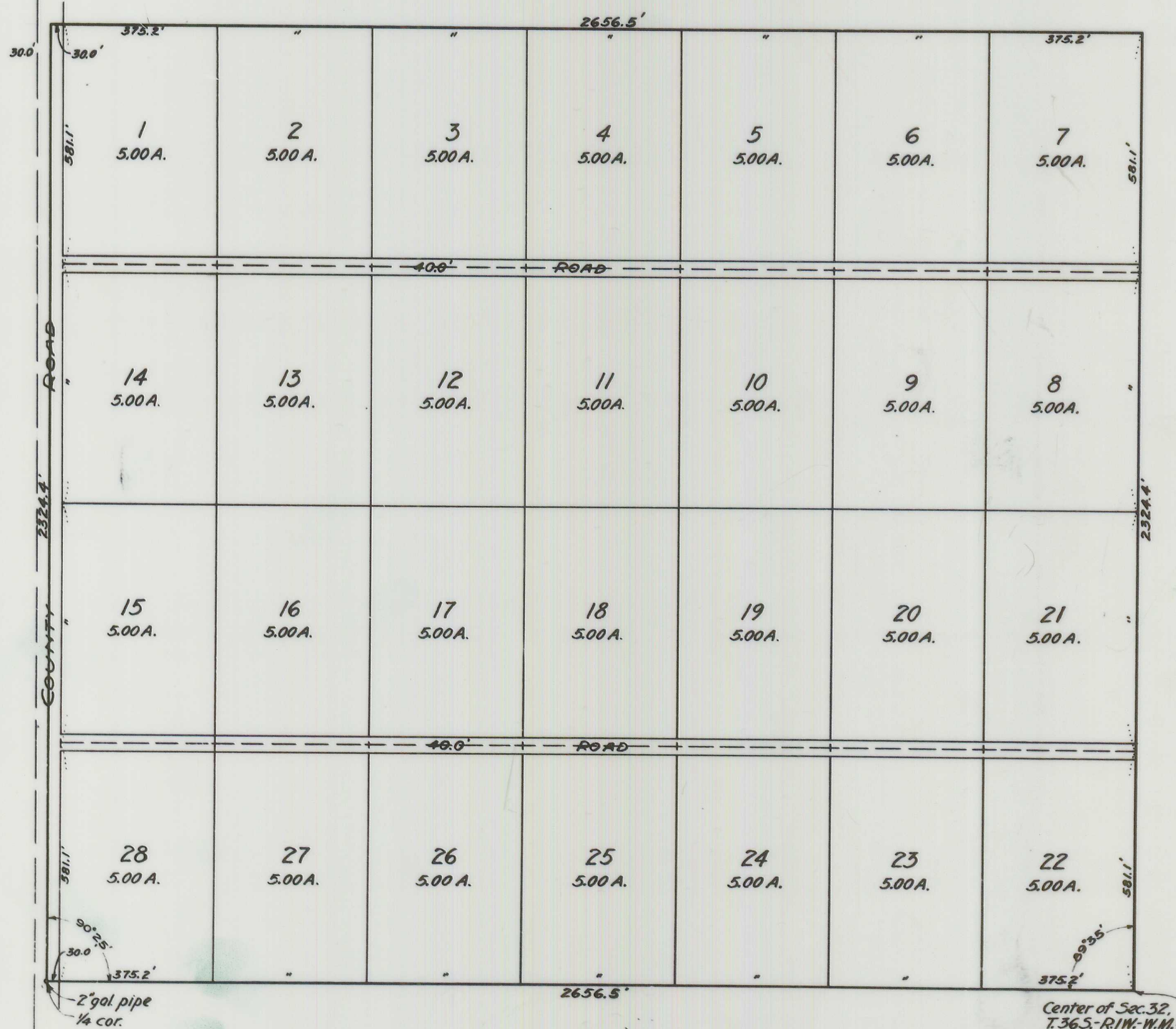


AMERICAN ORCHARD TRACTS
